Comments:

Avoid the use of the alternative, conjunctive phrase "and/or" as this is ambiguous. The word "either" may be used as a conjunctive when use of the word "or" does not indicate that the choices are mutually exclusive.

Response:

The "and/or" phrase is used three times in the document in reference to the traffic level mixtures contained in a project. There may be projects that have only one traffic level mixture or they may have two or three traffic level mixtures. A review of this spec with industry when it first came out did not reveal any confusion among reviewers. No change is needed.
