State Construction, State Materials and District Materials are working together to create a consistent Spec process to address the Investigation, Engineering Analysis and Disposition of failing materials. 346-10 will be affected by these changes. Recommend tabling 346-10 until this effort is complete. No comments on the other portions of 346.

Comments: (6-2-15)

346-10.1 vs 346-10.2: -10.1 says to either do a structural analysis or drill cores, so this seems to be the contractor's choice. -10.2, however, says to do a structural analysis when determined by the Dept. So the choice of cores vs. an analysis seems to be ultimately the Dept.'s decision. Suggest adding a sentence at the end of the second paragraph that says the Dept. will determine whether cores or a structural analysis are required. Suggest establishing two subsections of either 10-1 or 10.2 one for coring and one for structural analysis.
