ARTICLE 352-1 is deleted and the following substituted:

**352-1 Description.**

Grind existing concrete pavement in the areas designated on the Plans.

Grind new concrete pavement the full width of the travel lanes. Do not grind shoulders *or roundabout truck aprons*, unless indicated in the Plans or required to promote drainage.
