



Central Railroad Corridor Greenway (CRCG) Pedestrian Overpass

PROJECT BEGAN APRIL 26, 2017

On Wednesday, April 26, 2017, Infrastructure & Industrial Constructors USA, LLC, in conjunction with the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), began the Central Railroad Corridor Greenway (CRCG) Pedestrian Overpass project from west of I-95 to North County Regional Park.

This 2.017-mile project is anticipated to be completed by spring 2018, weather permitting. The cost for construction is \$4.6 million, and FDOT & Johnson-Adams & Associates, LLC will be overseeing the project.

This project is a critical link in the Indian River County and City of Fellsmere's greenway system, creating a shared use connection and encouraging alternative modes of travel. The new off-road trail using the old Trans-Florida Central Railroad right-of-way will connect the City of Fellsmere with the City of Sebastian, offering safe, convenient access for pedestrians and bicyclists. The goal of the greenway system is to increase environmental benefits while supporting wildlife protection and enhancing quality of life.

Scope of Work:

- Constructing a 12-foot shared use path and a pedestrian overpass over I-95, providing pedestrians and bicyclists with convenient access to area parks, conservation areas, recreational and educational facilities
- Maintaining an open drainage system with swales and minor culvert crossings
- Installing lighting, architectural towers, and specialty signage at the bridge location

Maintenance of Traffic:

To do this work safely, it will be necessary to close travel lanes on I-95 at various times and locations. Pacing operations on I-95 are permitted Sunday through Thursday night from 9:30 p.m. to 6 a.m., and will result in brief delays for motorists.
