About the Project

The Florida Department of Transportation's contractor is widening and reconstructing State Road 52 in Pasco County from two lanes to a four-lane divided highway from Bellamy Brothers Boulevard (CR 581) to Old Pasco Road.

The improvements will increase roadway capacity and improve safety along the corridor. Among the improvements are adding an additional lane in each direction, a 12-foot multi-use path along the north side of the road, and a 5-foot sidewalk along the south side.

A new traffic signal will be installed at the Old Pasco Road intersection and the signals will be replaced at the reconstructed intersection at Bellamy Brothers Boulevard.
