
Project Description

The Florida Department of Transportation's (FDOT) contractor, Condotte-deMoya JV, began construction on an \$83 million project to improve east-west traffic flow on Gandy Blvd. in Pinellas County in February 2014.

The elevated roadway provides a continuous flow of traffic by eliminating signals and minimizing entry and exit points along the roadway. Motorists will continue to have easy access, during and after construction, to local businesses through a frontage road access.

Major project features include:

Frontage roads will provide access to local businesses and residential communities



Improved Roadway Plan

An elevated roadway that includes:

- three lanes in each direction from I-275 to MLK Jr. Street N.
- two lanes in each direction from MLK Jr. Street N. to 4th Street N.

Three overpasses will be built at the following intersections:

- 94th Avenue
- MLK Jr. Street N.
- Roosevelt Blvd. N. and 4th Street N.

Frequently Asked Questions

I've heard this project is a "Design-Build." What does this mean?

The project is being constructed using a project delivery method known as "Design-Build." Under this method, a single team of contractors and engineers is responsible for designing and constructing the project. This differs from the more traditional "Design-Bid-Build" method where the design is completed first by engineers and then construction contractors are invited to bid for the opportunity to build the project.

Design-Build is a proven system that saves time and money. The various engineers and contractors work in partnership to deliver a high-quality project at the lowest possible price with an expedited schedule.

How will I be affected?

Lane closures will be necessary along Gandy Blvd., MLK Jr. Street N., Roosevelt Blvd. N., 4th Street N., 16th Street and 94th Avenue. Most closures will be done during off peak hours. During peak hours, three lanes in each direction will be available between I-275 and MLK Jr. Street N. and two lanes in each direction from MLK Jr. Street N. to east of 4th Street N. Detours will also be necessary. Most detours will occur on weekends.

How do I find out when traffic impacts, such as lane closures, are scheduled?

Various news media outlets, such as local TV and radio, newspapers, 511 and online traffic websites will be notified of any changes to traffic patterns.
