

Setting up Workstation Security for .NET on Local Networks

Microsoft .NET Framework must be loaded on the local workstation before the latest release of FDOT2002 (August 2004) will operate properly. The application “SheetNavigator” in the FDOT 2002 CADD Software Maintenance Release 3 is a .NET Application. The .NET framework can be downloaded from Microsoft with the Windows Update utility in Internet Explorer (Tools > Windows Update), or by visiting either of the following websites:

.NET needs to be set up on local workstations to trust local servers on your local LAN in order to run .NET programs residing on those servers properly. Here is how to set that up once the .NET framework has been installed:



Starting the .NET Wizards from Windows 2000 on the workstation:

1) Start > Settings > Control Panel > Administrative Tools > Microsoft .Net Framework 1.1 Wizards




2) Select the Wizard to adjust the .NET Security Settings on the local Workstation:

3) Choose to make changes to the Computer, then choose Next>



4) The Security for the Local Intranet to “Full Trust” as shown then select Next >



5) The following setting should now be in effect for .NET security on your workstation.
