

# Q&A for GEOPAK Basic Road for Roadway Designers – Ch 4 Part 1 of 2

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**Q: Is the scale factor should be the same as your plot scale?**

A: Yes, however, it does depend on which line style you are scaling and how the designer wants that line style to look in the plans.

**Q: Whenever civil 3d will be allowed to produce projects, it is going to have a D&C?**

A: Yes, it does. There is a similar tool developed by the ECSO called Entity Manager that has many of the same functions as the D&C Manager. There is also a tool called Quantity Takeoff that is used for quantities.

**Q: Is it possible to re-visualize specified items at a different scale without affecting all the points in a set?**

A: Yes, you can plot at multiple scales from the D&C Manager. This will be covered more in depth during next week's webinar.

**Q: Does the plot scale of the design file matter or does this plot scale override?**

A: The line style scale overrides the scale of the line style being placed from D&C. It does not override the plot scale of the file, since this option does not interact with the plot scale of the file. The D&C Manager will plot the custom line styles at the scale specified when the toggle is checked within the Design Settings dialog.
