

FDOT Construction Software and CSi Software Release Notes and Installation Guide July 2006

This document is provided as a guide to install the software updates. Please note that the FDOT Construction Software and CSi Software must now be installed separately. Therefore, it is strongly recommended that you read through this entire document prior to installing the updates.

Release Notes


The **FDOT Construction Software**, formerly part of the CSi Software suite, includes the following programs:

1. FDOT Quantities Programs (previously known as EngMenu or WinEng)
2. Multi-Line Earthwork (Version 7.2.0)

This is the full installation of the FDOT Construction Software and replaces all previous versions. **This software no longer requires a password.** There are no functional changes to the software from the previous certified versions.

For new Multi-Line Earthwork users there is a help file named **CSi Software 2005-2006.chm** available which contains step by step examples for some common Multi-Line Earthwork processes.

Also newly available are e-manuals for the FDOT Construction Software. Copy and paste the folder named “E-Manuals” to the local hard drive. Double-clicking **startCD.exe** in the “E-Manuals” folder launches the e-manuals. Then simply click on the e-manual cover you want to open. Instructions on how to navigate the e-manuals can be found in the on-line help.



It is recommended that a shortcut be added to the desktop for easy access of the e-manuals.

The **CSi Software** includes the following programs:

1. CanCogo (Version 4.1.0)
2. Grades (Version 6.2.1)

This is the full installation of the CSi Software and replaces all previous versions. **This software requires a new password.** There are no functional changes to the software from the previous certified versions.

If the user **does not** utilize the CSi Software programs, the old versions may be deleted, as users will be locked out of the programs after the current password expiration date, 08-31-2006. After this date, a **Warning** dialog will appear with the message “Your current password period has expired” as shown below.




To delete the old versions, navigate to the current hard drive location, generally C:\CSISYS, and delete the following folders, if present:

1. cancogo
2. Cancogo400
3. grades
4. WinGrades520



It is not necessary to uninstall previous versions of the software. To install, double-click **FDOTSetup.EXE**.


Welcome displays. Click **Next** to continue.



Choose Destination Location displays. Set this to the programs' current hard drive location, generally the default (C:\CSISYS), and click **Next** to continue.



Backup Replaced Files displays. Accept the default (**Yes**) and click **Next** to continue.




Select Components displays. Select the program(s) to install and click **Next** to continue.




Note: By default, both programs are installed.


Select Program Manager Group displays. Accept the default (**CSI SYSTEM**) and click **Next** to continue.




Start Installation displays. Click **Next** to continue.



Installing appears while the program(s) are installing.



Installation Complete appears when the program(s) finish installing. Click **Finish** to complete the installation.



IMPORTANT:

In order for the FDOT Construction Software to run correctly, modify rights must be given to the programs' directory (Destination Folder); generally C:\CSISYS. Otherwise, a Warning dialog reading **“Error 0203 error in saving message”** appears.


CSi Software Update Installation Notes

It is not necessary to uninstall previous software versions. The software must be installed locally and will not run off a server. To install, double-click **SetUp.EXE**.


Welcome displays. Click **Next** to continue.




Choose Destination Location displays. Set this to the programs' current hard drive location, generally C:\CSISYS, and click **Next** to continue.



Backup Replaced Files displays. Accept the default (**Yes**) and click **Next** to continue.




Select Components displays. Select the program(s) to install and click **Next** to continue.




Note: Although both programs are installed by default, install only the program(s) the user actually requires.

Select Program Manager Group displays. Accept the default (**CSI SYSTEM**) and click **Next** to continue.



Start Installation displays. Click **Next** to continue.



Installing appears while the program(s) are installing.



Installation Complete appears when the program(s) finish installing. Click **Finish** to complete the installation.



A new password for the CSi Software program(s) is required once installation is complete. When prompted to enter a password, request a password by completing the [Registration Request Form](#). Check **GRADES** or **CAN_COGO** as appropriate at the bottom of the Registration Request Form and enter the **System ID. #**, which is located in the center of the CSi Registration Form screen and can be copied and pasted into the Registration Request Form. Until the password is entered, the program can be accessed by selecting the **Trial** button at the bottom left of the Registration Form screen.
