## Professional Record

**FDOT Project No. 87075-3444; I-75 Rest Area** at MP 31 on Alligator Alley in Broward County. The work under this \$25.5 million dollar project consisted of the construction of a new rest area on I-75. Due to the environmentally sensitive location (The Florida Everglades) the facility was required to be self-sufficient. The facility consists of the main building, a new bridge, over 36,280 tons of asphalt and over 1,250,000 cubic yards of fill material. The project was completed within schedule and opened to the public in May, 2000.

**FDOT No. 231531-1-52-01 - I-75 Acceleration/Deceleration Ramps at MP 48 DESIGN-BUILD.** The scope of this project included the new construction of acceleration and deceleration ramps onto I-75. The \$3.5 million project was completed in 2001 within schedule.

**FDOT Project No. 232205-1-52-01; DESIGN-BUILD Milling and Resurfacing on SR-821** (Florida's Turnpike. The project valued at \$5.5 million was completed in 2000 within schedule. It consisted of milling and resurfacing over 14 miles of roadway in Broward County.

**SR-836 Widening from NW 107<sup>th</sup> avenue to NW 87<sup>th</sup> Avenue DESIGN-BUILD** for Miami-Dade Expressway Authority was completed in 2001. The \$2.5 million project included the addition of auxiliary lanes along a 6-lane freeway, new drainage system and resurfacing of existing mainline pavement.

**FDOT No. 249651-1-52-01; SR-826 (Palmetto Expressway) at NW 58<sup>th</sup> Street.** The \$15 million project completed in 2001, was done 3% ahead of schedule and 2% under the estimated budget. The project included bridge improvements, road widening, milling and resurfacing, as well as the micro-tunneling of three side by side 108" Reinforced Concrete Pipes under SR-826. Community Asphalt pursued this endeavor after submitting a VECP to the Department resulting in cost savings as well as overall superior design

and final product.
