Dear Mr. Knopp:

You received a copy of our letter, dated  to the Contractor for the above referenced project, whereby the Contractor was notified of a violation of Section (7) of the "required Contract Provisions – Federal Aid Construction Contracts" (FHWA 1273).

As a result of this violation, \$  in additional wages due and \$  in assessed liquidated damages were withheld from payment due on the progress estimate.


In response to our notification, the Contractor submitted certified supplemental payrolls indicating that corrective action has been taken in regard to the violations. The Contractor also explained the circumstances surrounding the violations.

The District Construction Office has reviewed the supplemental payrolls and is of the opinion that the affected employees have been properly compensated. Therefore, by copy of this letter, we are requesting that our Disbursement Operations Office release the \$  being withheld as unpaid wages.

The District Construction Office is also of the opinion that the violations were caused inadvertently. We therefore recommend that the \$  being withheld as liquidated damages be released.
