

**Earth Work Technical Review Team Meeting Minutes
April 28, 2005 at Florida's Turnpike Enterprise Offices in Orlando Florida**

Present were Technical Review Team (TRT) Members John Shoucair, Robert Shepard and EWTRT Chairperson Michael M. Pszyk III. Also present was Ms. Sandy Greenwood of the University of Florida.

The Earth Work Technical Review Team meeting began at 10:00AM and ended at 3:00PM on Friday April 28, 2005. The TRT meeting was held at Florida's Turnpike Enterprise Headquarters at Turkey Lake in Orlando Florida. The following items were discussed.

The Chairperson of the EWTRT, Michael M. Pszyk III asked all present to review the provided copies of chapters 1 and 10 of the Construction Training and Qualification Manual (CTQM).

The first order of business was to review the Provider Request for Approval submitted by the University of Florida. This request is made for the Earthwork Construction Inspection (ECI) Levels 1 and 2 Construction Training and Qualification Program (CTQP). It was noted at this time that the no other Provider Requests for Approval for the Earthwork Construction Inspection Levels 1 and 2 have been received.

The Provider Request for Approval submitted by the University of Florida contained their list of intended facilities and equipment, which was thoroughly examined by the TRT Members. It was noted by the Chairperson that the list contained District Office locations as well as the Turnpike Enterprise Snapper Creek Laboratory and Training facility. The Turnpike Enterprise is considering short term lease of its facility, however each District Office must be consulted by the University of Florida for use of their facilities. A comprehensive review of the Provider Request was conducted by the TRT Members. At the call for a vote by the Chairperson, a unanimous decision was made to recommend approval of the request made by the University of Florida for Provider of the ECI levels 1 and 2 CTQP courses.

The second order of business was to consider the Requests for Approval of the indicated Providers intended Instructors. Each Instructors Request was accompanied by their respective resume and pertinent teaching or training experience. A comprehensive review was conducted of each Instructors Request, at which time a vote was called for by the Chairperson regarding the indicated applicant by name and Training Identification Number (TIN).
