

Earth Work Technical Review Team Meeting Minutes
September 1, 2006 at Florida's Turnpike Enterprise Offices in Orlando Florida

Present were Technical Review Team (TRT) Members Ben Watson, Barbara Beacham, and EWTRT Chairperson Michael M. Pszyk III. Also present, Amy Seigler of CMEC, Al Mitchell FDOT, and Greenwood of the University of Florida.

The Earth Work Technical Review Team meeting began at 10:00AM and ended at 12:30PM on Friday September 1, 2006. The TRT meeting was held at Florida's Turnpike Enterprise Headquarters at Turkey Lake in Orlando Florida. The following items were discussed.

The Chairperson of the EWTRT, Michael M. Pszyk III asked all present to review the provided copies of the Minutes of the previous meeting. The Minutes were reviewed and accepted unanimously.

The first order of business was to review the Provider Request for Approval submitted by Parsons Brinckerhoff Construction Services, Inc. This request is made for the Earthwork Construction Inspection (ECI) Levels 1 and 2 Construction Training and Qualification Program (CTQP). The Provider Request also included a Request to Proctor Examinations which was not reviewed by the EWTRT as approval of Proctors is outside the purview of this committee. A review of the Provider Request made by Parsons Brinckerhoff Construction Services, Inc. indicated compliance with the requirements for facilities and classroom equipment. The Provider request did not contain reference to, or inclusion of photos of a de-sourced nuclear density/moisture gauge, required to perform the proficiency portion of the ECI Level 1 Course. The de-sourced nuclear density gauge intended for use by Parsons Brinckerhoff, Inc. must be added to the Provider Request. At the call for a vote by the Chairperson, a unanimous decision was made to recommend approval of the request made by Parsons Brinckerhoff Construction Services Inc. as Provider of the ECI levels 1 and 2 CTQP courses. Additionally, the Provider Request submitted by Parsons Brinckerhoff Construction Services, Inc. included as their intended Instructor Mr. Dan Bush, who was previously approved by the EWTRT.
