Since 1964 I have been continuously involved in land development, utility, highway and landfill construction. The value of these projects has ranged from less than \$100,000 to more than \$33,000,000. The work has been as varied as installation of 1" water pipe to 132" concrete cylinder pipe installed with custom designed and built tools and equipment. I have experience in earthwork, bridges, paving, and utilities. For four years I was Adjunct Professor at the University of North Florida teaching site construction classes in the Building Construction program. In 1981 I was retained as an expert witness by a construction claims attorney. During my employment with J. B. Coxwell Contracting, I served on the Utility, Scheduling and QC2000 Earthwork Specification FDOT Task Teams, and the FDOT/FTBA Specifications Committee. I am an FDOT listed Dispute Review Board Member.
