FEDERAL-AID INELIGIBILITY NOTICE RESOLUTION

8.1.1 Purpose

To establish a procedure for resolving Federal-Aid Ineligibility Notices (FAIN) by the State Construction Office (SCO). Federal-Aid Ineligibility Notices are issued for numerous reasons by the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), i.e., failure to meet specifications, work done by nonqualified personnel, skid test failure, material failure, etc.

8.1.2 Authority

Sections 20.23(3)(a) and 334.048(3), Florida Statutes

8.1.3 Resolution Process

Central Office Level Responsibilities

The following action shall be taken by the SCO after the FHWA issues a FAIN.

- (1) The FAIN is referred to the affected District Construction Engineer.
- (2) The State Construction Administration Specialist will work with appropriate District Construction Engineer to resolve and/or restore eligibility. Responsibility for the resolution of the FAIN is that of the District. Upon resolution, a ***Federal Aid Ineligibility Notice - Response***, [Form No. 700-010-62](#) is filled out by the State Construction Administration Specialist and distributed as follows:
