SUBJECT: FDOT 415 TEMPORARY CONCRETE BARRIER WALL UNITS

“FDOT 415 Temporary Concrete Barrier Wall Units,” are defined as temporary concrete barrier wall units with pin and loop connections utilizing steel snake pins and are detailed on Index 415 of the 2010 Design Standards and prior years. “FDOT 415 Temporary Concrete Barrier Wall Unit” has been phased out and is **no longer allowed on projects let July 1, 2012, and thereafter**. For projects let before July 2012, “FDOT 415 Temporary Concrete Barrier Wall Units” can continue to be used.

JJ Hook, a proprietary temporary concrete barrier listed on the Qualified Products List is not affected by the phase out and can continue to be used, before and after July 2012.

Type K Temporary Concrete Barrier System, detailed in Index 414 of the Design Standards, is not affected by the phase out and can continue to be used, before and after July 2012.

Low Profile Barrier, detailed in Index 412 of the Design Standards, is not affected by the phase out and can continue to be used, before and after July 2012.
