

Design wind speed: 150 MPH (Collier County) The Contractor shall provide and install an 18 Aluminum light pole. The pole arms and fixtures shall be provided by others (National Parks Service) for the Contractor to install on the poles.
Please supply cut sheets and any additional information for the National Park Service supplied light fixtures and pole arms. This will need to be engineered into the pole manufactures wind loading calculations and design. <p>On sheet # 20 there is a run of guardrail that also has a note in the lower right corner that says "Contractor shall use caution when installing guardrail post in the area of Sta. 2618+28-2618+40 LT. Proposed pipe lies underneath the ppost in this area." If the proposed pipe is to in this area, regardless if it is installed 1st or if the guardrail is installed 1st, the pipe will be in the way. 1. Why wouldn't there be a specail post pay item of encased post 536-7? If the pipe is less than 2 feet deep then that would not even work either. 2. should the designer re-look at his design and consider an alternative? 3. Will the Department add a pay item to the project of 536-7 Special Encased Post? It appears that there are other places were drainage pipes will be in the way of the guardrail.</p>	<p>Answer Posted on 6/24/2011 @ 8:47AM: The Department has reviewed the plans and finds no conflict with the proposed pipe and the proposed guardrail. <p>The special post issue is from page14-20. Since this is a unit price job, there should be no reason why it wasn't designed with a special encased post pay item 536-7 and a quantity.
