Prequalification Work Class: Hot-In-Place Resurfacing

To obtain qualification in the miscellaneous class of Hot-In-Place Resurfacing, the contractor shall comply with Rule 14-22, F.A.C. and provide the following:

1. A statement declaring at least three (3) years of experience in the active performance of Hot-In-Place asphalt production, with the use of its own forces as opposed to the use of subcontractors. Include up-to-date resumes for all superintendents.
2. A detailed statement describing the Hot-In-Place process used by the company.
3. A statement declaring that the company will perform all contract required Hot-In-Place work with its own forces. Hot-In-Place work is considered to include, but not limited to, (Heating, Removing, Replacing, Compacting and all associated QA/QC requirements set forth by the contract documents.) Include a detailed list of the equipment used to complete all related work.
4. A list of the Company's project history for the past 3 years, which must include at least three (3) projects. The list should include, but is not limited to: Project Names, Project Location, Project Owner, Project Contact Person and Phone Number, Project Beginning and Completion Date, Total Contract Amount. If the project was performed as a sub-contractor, include the name of the prime contractor, including contact person and phone number.
