- Prior to execution of the contract, a corporation must show proof that it is authorized to do business in the State of Florida. Florida Corporations should provide copy of the Certificate of Incorporation and Foreign Corporations should provide copy of Certificate of Authority from the Florida Department of State
- After awarded contracts are e-mailed to contractors, signed contracts must be returned within four (4) calendar days, excluding Saturdays, Sundays, and state holidays, with General Liability and Worker's Comp Insurance
- Work cannot begin until written authorization is given
- Contracts executed will require a performance bond when authorization is written
- All State and Federal rules and regulations apply
- Multiple Contracts may be awarded for each category
