PROJECT NAME

The Florida Department of Transportation (Department) has issued this Request for Proposal (RFP) to solicit competitive bids and proposals from Proposers for Safe Routes to School Sidewalk in Perry, Taylor County, Florida.

DESCRIPTION OF WORK

Construction of 5' wide concrete sidewalks with standard pavement markings. Ramps and tactile domes should be installed/replaced in the locations where the proposed sidewalk ties into the existing or proposed crosswalks. The location of stop bars and stop signs should be adjusted as necessary to accommodate the installation of the proposed crosswalks. All existing school warning signs, including flashing signs shall be brought up to current standards. New warning signs, crossing signs and marking shall be designed and constructed in accordance with current FDOT standards.

Veterans Drive from Jefferson Street to Clark Street:

- New sidewalk installed on the north side of Veterans Drive from Jefferson Street to Center Street to tie the existing sidewalks. Install Pedestrian signage and signals for crossing Veterans Drive at Center Street.
- Install crosswalks across the north and east legs of Jefferson Street. Advanced pedestrian crossing signage should be installed for the crosswalk.
- Install crosswalks across the north leg of Washington Street
- Install crosswalks across the north leg of Orange Street.
- Install a landing pad on the west leg of Center Street and Install crosswalk across the south leg of Center Street.
- Extend sidewalk installed on the west side of Aquanaldo Avenue to tie into existing sidewalk on the east side of Aquanaldo Avenue
- Extend sidewalk installed on west side of Bulldog Loop to tie into existing sidewalk on the east side of Bulldog Loop.
- Remove crosswalk across Veterans Drive at Margurite Street (west leg of intersection)

Lafayette Street from Jefferson Street to Bulldog Loop:

- Remove crosswalk across the west leg of Center Street.
- Remove the section of sidewalk that extends north from the existing sidewalk approaching Center Street.
- Extend sidewalk installed on west side of Jeff Davis Street to tie into existing sidewalk on the east side of Jeff Davis Street. Relocate crosswalk in front of the stop bars and stop signs.
- Extend sidewalk installed on west side of Aquanaldo Avenue to tie into existing sidewalk on the east side of Aquanaldo Avenue.
- Extend sidewalk installed on west side of Peacock Avenue to tie into existing sidewalk on the east side of Peacock Avenue.
- Extend sidewalk installed on west side of Manilla Avenue to tie into existing sidewalk on the east side of Manila Avenue. Relocate crosswalk in front of the stop bars and stop signs.

Clark Street from Main Street to Pinecrest Street:

- Extend sidewalk installed on the north side of Bay Street to tie into existing sidewalk and existing crosswalk on the west side of Clark Street.
- Remove two existing crosswalks south of Veterans Drive.
- Relocate stop bar and Stop sign at the west approach to the Veterans Drive to meet the minimum spacing requirement.
- Install a small section of sidewalk on the south side of Veterans Drive to tie the existing sidewalk on the west side of Clark Street into the existing crosswalk across the west leg of the intersection.
- Install sidewalk along the west side of Clark Street from the crosswalk across the west leg of the Veterans Drive intersection north to the crosswalk north of the Veterans Drive intersection.
- Install sidewalk along the east side of Clark Street from the crosswalk north of the Veterans Drive intersection north to the end of the existing sidewalk at the Perry Primary School faculty parking lot.
- New sidewalk installed on the north side of Pinecrest Street to tie the existing sidewalk along the north side of Pinecrest Street into the existing crosswalk across the east leg of the intersection.

Main Street from Jefferson Street to Clark Street:

- Extend sidewalk installed on west side of Aquinaldo Avenue to tie into existing sidewalk on the east side of Aquinaldo Avenue. Relocate crosswalk in front of the stop bars and stop signs.
- New sidewalk installed on the south side of Main Street from the end of the existing sidewalk approximately 170' (driveway of 603 Main Street) to North Peacock Avenue.
- New sidewalk installed on the south side of Main Street from Arena Avenue to Clark Street.
- Install crosswalk across the south leg of Arena Avenue.
- Install crosswalk across the south leg of Blair Avenue.
- Install crosswalk across the south leg of Hinley Avenue
- Install crosswalk across the south leg of Elmo Scott Avenue.

North Peacock Avenue from East Main Street to East Leon Street:

- Sidewalk shall be installed on the east side of North Peacock Street. Begin at East Main Street and end at the existing sidewalk on East Lafayette Street.

Bulldog Loop from East Lafayette Street to East Veterans Drive:

- Sidewalk shall be installed on the east side of Bulldog Loop. Begin at East Lafayette Street and end at the existing sidewalk on East Veterans Drive.
- A Utility conflict box along this section will need to be researched and addressed.

DESIGN BUILD TEAM REQUIREMENTS:

The Contractor and Design professionals cannot be on more than one team. The secondary member (i.e., designer or contractor) of the design build team cannot change, after award, without the written approval of the District Secretary.

A professional firm shall not submit a proposal for CEI services, either as a Prime or a Sub, for a Design-Build contract for which the same firm or its affiliate is the Engineer of Record (EOR) or is Sub to the EOR.

A consultant firm, its affiliate, or sub consultant that is under contract with the Department to develop the Request for Proposal for a Design Build contract cannot be part of a Design Build Team proposing on that contract as a prime or a sub consultant. A consultant firm, its affiliate, or sub consultant, that is under contract with the Department to provide Construction Engineering and Inspection (CEI) services on the Design Build contract cannot be part of a Design Build Team proposing on that contract as a prime or sub consultant.

PREQUALIFICATION:

Pre-qualification requirements for Design Build Advertisements for the contractor and design professional members of the Design Build team must be in accordance with the following (**Rule Chapter 14-91 F.A.C.**).

1) Contractors submitting as a lead or primary party with the design build team must be qualified in the advertised construction contractor work classes, in accordance with the provisions of **Rule Chapter 14-22, F.A.C.** In this case, where the design professional is not the lead of the design-build team, the design professional will be utilized to meet the professional consultant work type requirements, in accordance with provisions of **Rule 14-75, F.A.C.**

(2) Design professionals submitting as lead of the design-build team may utilize subcontractors to meet the advertised construction contractor work class requirements, in accordance with the provisions of **Rule Chapter 14-22, F.A.C.** In this case, the lead design professional will meet the professional consultant work type requirements, in accordance with provisions of **Rule 14-75, F.A.C.**

(3) When a joint venture party submits a Letter of Interest, one of the contractor members of the joint venture party must be assigned to meet the advertised construction contractor work class requirements, in accordance with the provisions of **Rule Chapter 14-22, F.A.C.** In this case, the design professional member of the team will be utilized to meet the professional consultant work type requirements, in accordance with provisions of **Rule 14-75, F.A.C.**

RESPONSE PROCEDURE:

Prequalified firms interested in being considered for the project should request a project package (Project Criteria and Request for Proposal) by submitting the fax request form found on the District Two District Contracts website located at: <http://www.dot.state.fl.us/contractsadministrationdistrict2>.

RESPONSE DUE DATE:

Project packages will be mailed to those firms that have requested them on or before June 2, 2009. This Project has a Mandatory Pre-Proposal Conference on June 2, 2009 at 10:00 a.m. at the Lake City District Office, 1109 S. Marion Avenue, Lake City, Florida. Plans, Specifications and Proposal Packages will no longer be available after the Mandatory Pre-Proposal Conference.

DUE DATE FOR BID PROPOSALS WITH TECHNICAL PROPOSALS:

Bid proposals with technical proposals will be due to the District Contracts Office on June 24, 2009 on or before 2:00 p.m. No late bids with technical proposals will be accepted after the 2:00 p.m. deadline of the bid due date.

SELECTION PROCEDURE:

Firms shall submit a bid proposal and a technical proposal. All bids will be opened and the technical proposal of the lowest bidder shall be evaluated by the FDOT to determine if it is responsive and responsible. If the proposal is deemed non-responsive or non responsible, the technical proposal of the next lowest bidder will be evaluated. The Department shall reserve the right to reject any and all proposals and waive minor proposal irregularities.

DBE REQUIREMENTS:

The Florida Department of Transportation (hereinafter referred to as the "Department"), in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, 78 Stat. 252, 42 USC 2000d to 2000d-4 and related authorities and Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations, U.S. Department of Transportation, Subtitle A, Office of the Secretary, Part 21, Nondiscrimination in Federally-assisted programs of the U.S. Department of Transportation issued pursuant to such Act, hereby notifies all bidders that the Department will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, minority business enterprises and disadvantaged business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation. Further, the

Department will not discriminate against bidders on the grounds of race, color, national origin, sex, age, or disability/handicap in consideration for an award. No company will be awarded a contract unless they have an approved DBE Affirmative Action Program Plan. **Please review the "DBE Bid Package" and the Special Provisions for instructions for submission of a DBE Affirmative Action Plan.**

BONDING REQUIREMENTS:

Firms submitting bids will be required to provide a 5% bid bond for each bid in excess of \$150,000.00.

The legal entity contracting with the Department will be required to provide the Department a performance and payment bond in the amount of the bid. The successful firm will be required to maintain in effect throughout the life of the contract a performance and payment bond for 100% of the contract amount. The Surety Company must be authorized to do business in the State of Florida.

The legal entity contracting with the Department must provide project specific Professional Liability Insurance covering errors and omissions in the amount of \$1,000,000 unless each team member providing professional services carries and maintains blanket Professional Liability Insurance covering errors and omissions in the amount of \$1,000,000. Project specific insurance is insurance covering only this project. Blanket insurance is insurance that covers all projects. All Profession Liability Insurance, Protective Public Liability and Property Damage insurance and other insurance policies that the Contract Documents may require the Florida Department of Transportation to be named as an additional insured, shall so provide in the policy or in an appropriate rider to the policy. All certificates of insurance related thereto shall also confirm that the related insurance policies specifically name the Department as an additional insured. All certificates of insurance must also have original signatures and be issued within 30 days prior to submittal to the Department.

PROTEST RIGHTS:

"Failure to file a protest within the time prescribed in section 120.57(3), Florida Statutes, or failure to post the bond or other security required by law within the time allowed for filing a bond shall constitute a waiver of proceedings under chapter 120, Florida Statutes."
