The following change has been made to subject contract;

1.) Request for Proposal, SECTION VI – Design and Construction Criteria, Q – ITS PLANS, 7 – ITS Testing and Warranty (Page 41 of 181) –

1<sup>st</sup> Bullet, Component hardware failure – DELETE “within forty-eight (48) hours for non-emergency of notice of failure”. INSERT “within twenty-four (24) business hours for non-emergency after notice of failure. Non-emergency work will be required between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, excluding holidays”.

2<sup>nd</sup> Bullet, Component Software failure - DELETE “within forty-eight (48) hours for non-emergency of notice of failure”. INSERT “within twenty-four (24) business hours for non-emergency after notice of failure. Non-emergency work will be required between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, excluding holidays”.

3<sup>rd</sup> Bullet, Infrastructure failure - DELETE “within forty-eight (48) hours for non-emergency of notice of failure”. INSERT “within twenty-four (24) business hours for non-emergency after notice of failure. Non-emergency work will be required between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, excluding holidays”.

2.) Request for Proposal, Section VI – Design and Construction Criteria, I- Shop Drawings, Second Paragraph, Page 24 of 49 ( 28 of 181) – DELETE “10 working day”. INSERT “45 day”.

3.) Request for Proposal, Section VI – Design and Construction Criteria, Q – ITS Plans, 7. ITS Testing and Warranty Requirements, Burn-In, Last Paragraph - Page 42 Of 49 (46 of 181) – DELETE “30-day”. INSERT “60-day”.

4.) Request for Proposal, Attachment Number 1 - INSERT in the ADMS & STRUCTURE SOUTHBOUND Column at I-95 SB Ramp – “WIRELESS ASSEMBLY REQUIRED. INSERT in CROSS STREET COLUMN at Avenues Walk – Southside Boulevard.

ADD THE FOLLOWING NOTE TO ATTACHMENT NUMBER 1 FOR CLARIFICATION: Wireless Assemblies are needed at the following locations; 1.) Fire Station (Approximate Station 171+40). 2.) Avenues Walk/ Southside Blvd (Approximate Station 208+65) 3.) I-95 SB ON and Off Ramps (Approximate Station 243+80). 4.) Arterial Dynamic Message Sign (Approximate Station 256+90). A dual channel wireless assembly is not needed.

5.) Request for Proposal, Attachment Number 3 – INSERT at Southside Boulevard – Avenues Walk.

6.) Request for Proposal, Attachment Number 4 – INSERT AT AVENUES WALK – Southside Boulevard.  
DELETE Wireless Requirement at Shad Road.
