#### **Federal, State, and Local Rules and Regulations.**

The term "Federal, State and Local Rules and Regulations" includes: all laws, bylaws, ordinances, rules, regulations, order, permits, or decrees including Federal, State, and Local environmental laws, rules and regulations.

### **SECTION 7 LEGAL REQUIREMENTS AND RESPONSIBILITY TO THE PUBLIC**

SUBARTICLE 7-1.1 (Pg 57) the seventh paragraph is replaced with the following:

The Contractor shall indemnify, defend, and save harmless the Department and all of its officers and agents, and employees against all claims or liability arising from or based on the violation of any Federal, State, and Local Rules and Regulations; whether by himself or his employees.

SUBARTICLE 7-1.1 (Pg 57) the eighth paragraph is replaced with the following:

The Contractor shall comply with all Federal, State, and Local Rules and Regulations, including any measures identified by the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System Permit, and/or NPDES Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan and Sediment and Erosion Control Plan for the work.

### **SECTION 104 PREVENTION, CONTROL AND ABATEMENT OF EROSION AND WATER POLLUTION.**

The Contactor shall submit a Debris Disposal Plan with the bid and obtain the Engineer's approval for the location of all disposal areas including' commercially operated sources furnished for waste material from the project. The Department shall review and approve the Debris Disposal Plan prior to contract execution. The Contractor will have no more than 60 days in which to secure approval from the Department or be found non-responsible. Obtain the Engineer's approval for the location, and method of operation in all borrow pits, material pits, and disposal areas including commercially operated sources furnished for waste material from the project such that erosion during and after completion of the work will not result in probability of detrimental siltation or water pollution.

You must sign, date and fax a copy of this addendum back to me by close of business today to indicate receipt. The bidder is required to acknowledge the addendum in the space provided on the proposal.


