

Final Selection Formula has been revised as follows: “The Department has established several priorities in the form of bid alternatives for contract award. These alternatives begin with a Project Base Concept as Bid Alternative 1 and increases in scope until the full scope as described in the RFP is achieved with Bid Alternative 3 as being the highest priority.</p> <p>The Bid Price Proposal for each of the three (3) Bid Alternatives shall be sealed in separate envelopes prior to submittal to the Department.</p> <p>The Department intends to award the Contract to the highest priority with a responsive Technical Proposal and Bid Price Proposal less than or equal the Department’s available funds for the Project. The Design-Build Firm <u>is required to shall</u> submit a separate Bid Price Proposal for each Bid Alternative, <u>even if the</u></p>

Bid Price Proposal is higher than the available funding or shall be declared non-responsive. The Bid Price Proposal for each of the three (3) Bid Alternatives shall be sealed in separate envelopes prior to submittal to the Department.

The Department shall award the contract to the responsive Design-Build Firm with the lowest adjusted score for the highest priority Bid Alternative within the Department's available funds for the Project. ~~The highest priority for which there is at least one responsive Bid Price Proposal will be selected.~~ Adjusted score will be used to determine the successful bidder only if there are two or more responsive Bid Price Proposals for the selected Priority as follows:-”

~~“Should the Department not receive a responsive proposal for Bid Alternative 3, the Department shall then award the contract to the responsive Design-Build Firm with the lowest adjusted score for the next highest priority Bid Alternative within the Department's available funds for the Project as declared prior to Bid Opening. In the event that all Bid Price Proposals for Bid Alternative 1 exceed the declared funding amount, the Department reserves the right to determine (based on the availability of additional funds) whether to consider the Bid Price Proposals for Bid Alternative 1, and factor the Adjusted Scores based on those Bid Price Proposals. The Department will determine whether making an Award is in the best interest of the State.”~~
