PREQUALIFICATION OF BIDDERS.

ARTICLE 2-1 (Pages 9 and 10) is expanded by the following:

This Contract requires the Contractor to be prequalified in R&R Major Bridges - Bridges of Conventional Construction which are over a water opening of 1,000 feet or more, and Cathodic Protection.

The low bidder must provide evidence to the FDOT Contracts Administration office prior to award that the Contractor or Subcontractor performing Concrete Rehabilitation (Spall Repair), and Electrical Work is prequalified in accordance with Section 337.14(1), Florida Statutes, and Rule 14-22, Florida Administrative Code.
