American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009: This project has been identified by the Department for advertisement and award subject to criteria and conditions established under the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (also known as the Federal Economic Stimulus Bill). There will be federal reporting requirements associated with this project, such as monthly reports of number of jobs created and the number of jobs retained by this project or activity. The exact nature and extent of the reporting requirements and format for data collection are not fully known at this time but will be provided by the Department when made available by FHWA.

This project is pending Federal Funds Approval and FDOT authorization. There will be NO compensation for preparation of a technical proposal for this project.

Shortlist is contingent upon Legislative Budget Approval of funds, therefore dates noted in the advertisement beginning with the shortlist date and dates after the shortlist may change. Changes will be noted on the Professional Services website and all shortlisted firms will be notified.

Actual commitment and final execution of this contract is contingent upon an approval of Legislative Budget and availability of funds.

Awarded contractor shall have 20 days to execute the contract.

All dates noted in this advertisement for this project are anticipated dates and are subject to change.

Credit will be given in the Technical Proposal Evaluation for firms that commit to have work performed by Small Businesses as defined by the USDOT, (49 CFR Part 26.65).

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: CONSTRUCTION and DESIGN of the widening of I-95 with the addition of one lane in each direction. Acceleration and deceleration lanes will be added to the ramps at Malabar Road and the ramps south of Palm Bay Road. DESIGN CONSULTANT services will include preparation of complete construction plans in accordance with FDOT standards. Construction work will include bridge, roadway and drainage construction, utility coordination, permitting, and maintenance of traffic.

Three (3) firms shall be shortlisted from the responses to this solicitation. The award of the project will be based on an adjusted score using a combination of the price and technical proposal grade. Compensation for proposals is not being offered on this project.
