The Request for Proposal for the above referenced project is amended as follows:

- 1. Page 75 of 83, Section IV, Technical Requirements addition of "Commitment to Disadvantaged and Small Business Enterprise":**

IV. Technical Proposal Requirements.

B. Submittal Requirements:

Section 1: Written Technical Proposal

Commitment to Disadvantaged and Small Business Enterprise

The Design/Build Firm shall identify how it plans to attract, utilize and manage Disadvantaged and Small Business Enterprise (SBE) firms for this project. As part of the Bid Price Proposal, the Design/Build Firm will indicate the level of SBE Utilization the Design/Build Firm will commit to during the execution of the contract. The commitment will be expressed as a percentage (rounded to the nearest tenth) of the Bid Price Proposal.

After execution of the contract, the Department will monitor compliance with this commitment. In the event the Design/Build Firm fails to achieve the percentage committed for SBE utilization, the Design/Build Firm will be charged, as liquidated damages and not as a penalty, a dollar amount equal to one half the unfulfilled SBE commitment. If the failure to meet the SBE commitment is due to factors outside the Design/Build firms control, and the Design/Build firm demonstrates to the Engineer the Design/Build firm has exercised good faith efforts to overcome the shortfall in SBE commitment, the Engineer, at his sole direction, can waive these liquidated damages.

By execution of the Contract Documents, the parties acknowledge and agree that failure to meet the SBE commitment for which the Design/Build Firm was given credit in the Technical Proposal score will result in damages being suffered by the Department and/or the traveling

public which are difficult to ascertain with certainty. Parties further acknowledge and agree that the amount of liquidated damages stated above is a best estimate of the actual damages that would be suffered and is a reasonable amount based on the best available information.

The Contractor will report, with each invoice, the payments made to SBE firms using a form provided by the Department after the award of the contract. The forms will require the Contractor to identify each of the SBE firms that are receiving payments that will contribute to the fulfillment of the SBE utilization commitment. For each SBE firm that is identified, the Contractor must provide certification of the firm's SBE status. This certification shall be included with first invoice that identifies payment to each SBE firm.

2. Page 80 of 83, Section IV, Technical Requirements, Subsection C, Evaluation Criteria is amended as follow:

C. Evaluation Criteria:

The Technical Review Committee shall evaluate the written Technical Proposal by each Design/Build Firm. The Design/Build Firm should not discuss or reveal elements of the price proposal in the written proposals. A technical score for each firm will be based on the following criteria:
