Notice to Contractors / Consultants:

The Department of Transportation (Department) is soliciting contracting and consulting services for the Design-Build projects identified below.

QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS: Design-Build Firms must be qualified in accordance with Rule Chapter 14-91, Florida Administrative Code. Design-Build Firms shall satisfy the technical qualification requirements of Rule 14-75, and all qualification requirements of Rule Chapter 14-22, Florida Administrative Code. The Contractor or Joint Venture members collectively, must be qualified in the advertised Construction Contractor Work Classes. The Contractor or Joint Venture cannot utilize subcontractors to meet the qualification requirements for the Construction Work Classes. The Design Consultant may utilize sub-consultants to meet the advertised Professional Services Work Type requirements. All qualification requirements must be met prior to the Response Deadline. Two or more qualified parties submitting as a Joint Venture must meet the Joint Venture requirements of Rule Chapter 14-22, specifically Rule 14-22.007, Florida Administrative Code. Parties to a Joint Venture must submit a Declaration of Joint Venture, Form No. 375-020-18, and receive approval from the Department prior to the Response Deadline for submittal of the Proposal.

NEW FORM MUST BE SUBMITTED FOR BRIDGE DESIGN PROJECTS: Design-Build Firms responding to advertisements requiring Group 4 Bridge Design work type qualification must submit a completed and signed [Bridge Qualification form](#) along with the Technical Proposal, by the date/time deadline established for the Technical Proposal. Please refer to this preamble and advertisement for other submittal directions.

CONSULTANT ELIGIBILITY: It is a basic tenet of the Department's contracting program that contracts are procured in a fair, open, and competitive manner.

The Department requires that consultants representing the Department must be free of conflicting professional or personal interests. In order to prevent potential conflicts of interest, the Department has established guidelines to be followed by design consultants. Please familiarize yourself with the requirements of Procedure No. 375-030-006, also known as: "Restriction on Consultants' Eligibility to Compete for Department Contracts." By submitting an Technical Proposal or Bid/Price Proposal as part of a Design-Build Firm, or Joint Venture, the design consultant certifies that they are in compliance with Procedure No. 37-030-006.

A Proposal Guaranty of not less than five percent (5%) of the total actual Bid/Price Proposal in the form of either a certified check, cashier's check, trust company treasurer's check, bank draft of any national or state bank, or a Surety Bid Bond made payable to the Florida Department of Transportation must accompany each Bid/Price Proposal in excess of \$150,000. A check or draft in any amount less than five percent (5%) of the actual Bid/Price Proposal will invalidate the Bid/Price Proposal. Bid Bonds shall conform to DOT Form No. 375-020-34 furnished with the Bid/Price Proposal.

For those projects designated as **LOW BID TYPE**, Technical and Bid/Price Proposals must be

submitted by the date and time indicated in the Advertisement. It is the responsibility of the Design-Build Firms to insure that Technical and Bid/Price Proposals are received timely. The Department shall open all Bids received at a public Bid opening on the date found in Section II of this RFP. The Technical Review Committee will review the Technical Proposal of the Lowest Bidder. The Technical Review Committee will then establish if the Technical Proposal of the Lowest Bidder is responsive or non-responsive based on the criteria described in this RFP. If the Proposal is responsive, that Design-Build Firm will be awarded the Project. If the Proposal is found to be non-responsive, the Technical Review Committee will review the Technical Proposal of the next Lowest Bidder and establish if the Technical Proposal is responsive or non-responsive based on the criteria described in this RFP, and so on.

All Bid openings and public meetings will be held in District headquarters unless otherwise noted. Changes to meeting dates and times will be updated under the All Advertisements link. The selection results will be posted on the Department's website (www.dot.state.fl.us/procurement) at the date and time indicated in the advertisement.

The agenda for all public meetings is as follows: a) Opening Remarks (approx. 3 minutes); b) Public Input (15 minutes); c) Department business; d) Closing. For more information, contact the designated responsible office. The selection results will be posted on the Department's website (<http://www.dot.state.fl.us/construction/DesignBuild/AllSites/DesignBuildSites.shtm>) at the date and time indicated in the advertisement. Partners/Teaming Arrangements of the Design-Build Firm shall not be changed after submittal of the Proposal on **LOW BID TYPE** projects without written consent of the Department. Failure to receive approval on such a change will result in the Proposal being declared non-responsive.

Note: The Department reserves the right to reject all Proposals and/or to waive minor Proposal irregularities.

The Contractor or Lead Design Professional shall not team with other Proposers to submit more than one Proposal per project.

COMMUNICATIONS BETWEEN DESIGN-BUILD FIRMS AND DEPARTMENT: In order to ensure a fair, competitive and open process, once a project is advertised under Current Advertisements, all communications between interested firms and the Department must be directed to the Departments Pre-bid Question and Answer website (<http://www2.dot.state.fl.us/construction/bidquestionmain.asp>) or to the appropriate Procurement Office as provided in the advertisement after bid submittal.

Respondents to this solicitation or persons acting on their behalf may not contact any employee or officer of the executive or legislative branch, between the release of the solicitation and the end of the 72-hour period following the agency posting the notice of intended award, excluding Saturdays, Sundays, and state holidays, concerning any aspect of this solicitation, except in writing to the procurement officer or as provided in the solicitation documents. Violation of this provision may be grounds for rejecting a response.

Pursuant to Sections 120.57(3) and 337.11, Florida Statutes, and Rule Chapter 28-110, Florida Administrative Code, any person adversely affected by the agency decision or intended decision shall file with the agency both a notice of protest in writing and bond within 72 hours after the

posting of the notice of decision or intended decision, or posting of the solicitation with respect to a protest of the terms, conditions, and specifications contained in a solicitation and will file a formal written protest within ten days after the filing of the notice of protest. The required notice of protest and bond, and formal written protest must each be timely filed with the **Florida Department of Transportation, Clerk of Agency Proceedings, 605 Suwannee St, Mail Station 58, Tallahassee, FL 32399-0458**. Failure to file a notice of protest or formal written protest within the time prescribed in section 120.57(3), Florida Statutes, or failure to post the bond or other security required by law within the time allowed for filing a bond shall constitute a waiver of proceedings under Chapter 120 Florida Statutes.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Department of Transportation will issue a Request for Proposal (RFP) to solicit competitive bids and proposals from Proposers for ITS elements such as colored Dynamic Message Signs (DMS), Close Circuit Television Cameras (CCTV Cameras), Microwave Vehicle Detector Stations (MVDS) and Fiber Optic Cable to be installed, replaced or maintained on I-75 as specified in the RFP. The project limits are approximately 1 mile South of SR 44 to ½ mile north of US 27 on Interstate 75.

A new 96 SM fiber optic cable shall be installed as FDOT's ITS Infrastructure Communication Network. The new backbone fiber shall be installed throughout the length of the project. The existing ITS infrastructure and sites to include but not limited to the cabinet, power, poles and pull boxes may be utilized if Specifications are met. Additional ITS sites including CCTV, MVDS, and DMS's shall to be installed to meet the RFP requirements. Colored DMS's will be installed within the project limits to include High Definition CCTVs and MVDS. The fiber tie-in point on the south side shall remain the same with the Turnpike. The fiber tie-in point on the north side shall remain in a splice vault with enclosure for future projects. Another tie-in point with the City of Ocala shall take place within the project limits with the city's recommendation.

This project requires furnishing and installing all the necessary components for fully functional ITS system. The existing ITS facilities are specified in the RFP

No ground mounted cabinet shall be removed or replace within this project. The replacement or installation of new devices shall be integrated into the District 5 Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) and operation at the Regional Traffic Management Center (RTMC) via the SunGuide Software.

NOT TO EXCEED BUDGET AMOUNT OR MAXIMUM BUDGET AMOUNT OR BUDGET AMOUNT*: Contract Maximum Bid Price is \$5,107,039.00

*Actual commitment and final execution of this contract is contingent upon an approved Legislative budget and availability of funds

RESPONSE PROCEDURE:

TECHNICAL PROPOSAL

The Technical Proposal and required attachments shall be submitted electronically in adobe.pdf format (unzipped) and attached to a single email. The Department has a 5MB limit on email. Emails that exceed this 5MB email server limit may be rejected by the Department's email server. It is solely the Design Build Firm's responsibility to ensure that the Technical Proposal is received by the Department's server by the due date and time. Only (1) Technical Proposal per legal entity is acceptable. All Technical Proposal files should be sent to d5.designbuild@dot.state.fl.us and must be received by the Department by the response deadline shown below.

Bid Proposal Requirements.

Bid Price Proposal:

Price Proposals (Bids) must be submitted through the Departments Online Bidding system (Bid Express at [https://www.bidx.com/.](https://www.bidx.com/)) in accordance with the requirements contained in the Request for Proposal. Bids not submitted through the Bid Express system will be considered non-responsive and not evaluated.

DBE/MBE REQUIREMENTS: For this project, the Department has established an aspiration goal of 9.0% DBE usage and an additional 3.0% Non-DBE Small Business usage, representing a cumulative 12.0% commitment of total contract costs. Firms proposing for this Project shall aspire to have 9.0% or more of the total contract costs performed by DBE's and an additional 3.0% or more of the total contract costs performed by Non-DBE Small Businesses.

Although not a contract requirement, the Department believes that the aforementioned aspiration goal can realistically be achieved based on current availability of DBEs and small businesses. The Department further believes that the 12% overall goal can be achieved through race neutral means, using standard competitive procurement processes. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 339.0805, Florida Statutes, and rule 14.78.005, Florida Administrative Code, the Department has adopted rules to provide certified DBEs opportunities to participate in the business activities of the Department as vendors, contractors, subcontractors, and consultants. The Department has adopted the DBE definition set forth in Code 49 of Federal Regulations Section 26.5.
