This contract will have a term of 36 months. The TRC ranked the four shortlisted firms by technical proposals (with a maximum possible score of 100 points), by interviews (also up to 100 points) and by their price proposals (also up to 100 points). The district offered the firms a range of rates; all of the firms picked the lowest offered rate (\$240), so they were scored the same for their price proposals. The TRC ranked the five shortlisted firms by technical proposals (with a maximum possible score of 100 points), by interviews (also up to 100 points) and by their price proposals (up to 15 points). Two firms did not provide complete fee proposals, so they did not receive any points for their price proposals. Two year contract (with one year renewal option), executed on May 18, 2010, and due to expire on May 17, 2013. A six month time extension, to November 17, 2013, with the additional funds, is requested to add programmed and authorized funds to the contract to develop a specific mitigation site on Lower Matecumbe Key as required by environmental permits obtained for the shoulder widening project on Grassy Key (project number 425600-4), which will be let soon. This amendment is for task work order (TWO) 25, which will revise the drainage design from Ocean View Blvd/Lime Street/Lycaloma Avenue (Sta. 550+00) to Lobster Lane (Sta. 574+00) to avoid conflicts with the 6" vacuum line that was installed by the Key Largo Wastewater Treatment District (KLWTD). The line was not installed as per the permits and without the re-design it would conflict with project number 419848-1 (S.R. 5/Overseas Highway from MM 93 to MM 97). KLWTD will reimburse the department. This will be the last TWO for design work under this contract. The last project designed under this contract will be let in May 2013.
