NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Town of Medley will receive sealed bids for construction services for the NW 121st Way Bridge over C-6 Canal (Bridge No. 876300) Re-surfacing and Markings Improvements Project until 3:00 p.m., Eastern Standard Time on Monday, December 13, 2010, at the Town Clerk's office, at the Medley Municipal Services Facility 7777 N.W. 72nd Avenue, Medley, Florida 33166.

Scope of Services

The work specified in this bid consists of furnishings all labor, machinery, tools, means of transportation, supplies equipment, materials, and services necessary for the NW 121st Way Bridge over C-6 Canal (Bridge No. 876300) Re-surfacing and Markings Improvements Project, located in Medley, Florida. The work under this Project includes, but is not limited to:

the milling and resurfacing and the installation of new pavement markings on Bridge 876300, also known as the NW 121st Street Way Bridge, which crosses over the South Florida Water Management District C-6 canal also known as the Miami Canal.

ANY BID(S) RECEIVED AFTER 3:00P.M. on Monday, December 13, 2010, WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED AND WILL BE RETURNED TO THE BIDDER UNOPENED. Bids will be publicly opened at 3:05 P.M. on Monday, December 13, 2010, at the Medley Municipal Services Facility, Council Chambers, 7777 N.W. 72nd Avenue, Medley, Florida 33166. Any bids or proposals received after 3:00 P.M. prior to bid opening will be returned to the bidder unopened.

This project, in whole or in part, may be assisted through the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA) and State of Florida funding administered by the Florida Department of Transportation, and bidders must comply with all federal, state and local laws, ordinances and regulations.

Attendance to this Pre-Bid Conference meeting is encouraged and recommended as a source of information but is not mandatory.

Bid documents may be obtained Monday through Thursday from 9:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m. (not including Town of Medley legal holidays) on or after Monday, November 15, 2010, from the Office of the Town Clerk of the Town of Medley. A \$75.00 non-refundable

payment for plans and specifications is required.

A Bid Guaranty of 5% of the bid amount will be required with the Bid. The successful bidder will also be required to furnish Performance and Payment Bonds, each in the amount of one hundred (100%) percent of the Contract amount.

The bid will be awarded to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder, conditioned upon approval of funding through the Florida Department of Transportation. In awarding a contract pursuant to a bid, the Town Council shall consider all of the criteria set forth in the Instructions to Bidders, in compliance with all federal and state requirements and the ordinances and resolutions of the Town, and in addition thereto, may consider other facts or circumstances in awarding a contract. The Town Council shall not be required to award a contract to the lowest bidder nor shall it be required to award a contract at all. The Town Council at all times shall have the right, in its sole and absolute discretion, to waive any informality in any bid proposal, to increase or decrease the quantities shown in the Bid Form, or the Town may reject any and/or all bids.
