Requests for Bid Documents, Proposal Forms, along with Plans and Specifications must be signed and submitted on a State of Florida Department of Transportation, Fax Order Form 375-000-02, containing the required public records exemption certification at the time of the request. Bidders shall be responsible for ensuring that they have received complete bidding documents, plans and/or specifications. No refunds will be made.

VENDOR REGISTRATION

Effective immediately, all Contractors/Consultants/Vendors must be registered in the State of Florida's MyFloridaMarketplace system by the time and date the bids are due or they will be considered non-responsive. All work is to be done in accordance with the plans, specifications, and special provisions of the State of Florida Department of Transportation.

PREQUALIFIED CONTRACTOR NOTE

A contractor desiring to bid for the performance of any construction contract in excess of \$250,000.00 must first be certified by the Department as qualified in accordance with Section 337.14(1), Florida Statutes, and Rule 14-22, Florida Administrative Code. Any bid for the performance of any construction contract in excess of \$250,000.00 submitted by a contractor not certified by the Department as qualified shall be declared "IRREGULAR" and will be REJECTED.

Maintenance contracts do not require a contractor to have a certificate of qualification. If deemed necessary by the Department, certain maintenance contracts will contain specific requirements for maintenance contractor eligibility.

BIDDER'S CURRENT CAPACITY

In order for the Department to have the information required to determine a bidder's current capacity, it is necessary that the bidder submit on the day of the letting, a Certification of Current Capacity that shall be executed under oath and be accompanied and supported by a Status of Contracts on Hand Report. These documents must be included in at least one proposal for each letting that the Contractor submits bids. Failure to submit these documents may result in a determination that all bids submitted by the Contractor for that letting are non-responsive or irregular and not to be considered.

BID BOND

A Proposal Guaranty of not less than five percent (5%) of the total actual bid in the form of either a certified check, cashier's check, trust company treasurer's check, bank draft of any national or state bank, or a Surety Bid Bond made payable to the Department of Transportation must accompany each bid in excess of \$150,000.00. A check or draft in an amount less than five per cent (5%) of the actual bid will invalidate the bid. Bid Bonds shall conform to the Department of Transportation Form 375-020-09 furnished with the Proposal.

WAGE RATES

Wage Rates: Pursuant to the Florida Minimum Wage Act, Article X, Section 24, Constitution of the State of Florida, the minimum wage for all hours worked in Florida shall be \$6.79 per hour effective January 1, 2008.

AFFIRMATIVE ACTION

The Florida Department of Transportation (hereinafter referred to as the "Department"), in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, 78 Stat. 252, 42 USC 2000d to 2000d-4 and related authorities and Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations, U.S. Department of Transportation, Subtitle A, Office of the Secretary, Part 21, Nondiscrimination in Federally-assisted programs of the U.S. Department of Transportation issued pursuant to such Act, hereby notifies all bidders that the Department will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, minority business enterprises and disadvantaged business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation.

Further, the Department will not discriminate against bidders on the grounds of race, color, national origin, sex, age, or disability/handicap in consideration for an award. No company will be awarded a contract unless they have an approved DBE Affirmative Action Program Plan. Please review the "DBE Bid Package" and the Special Provisions for instructions for submission of a DBE Affirmative Action Plan.

DBE/MBE PARTICIPATION DATA BASE INFORMATION

Please complete, sign, and return the applicable DBE/MBE "Bid Opportunity List" Forms as stipulated in the subject bid packages.

DEBARMENT OR SUSPENSION OF CONTRACTOR

The following statement shall be included in all bids submitted to the Department: "By signing and submitting this proposal, we/I certify that no principal (which includes officers, directors or executives) is presently debarred, suspended, proposed for debarment, declared ineligible or voluntarily excluded from participation in this transaction by any federal department or agency."

AUTHORIZED TO DO BUSINESS IN THE STATE OF FLORIDA

Prior to execution of the contract with the Department, a corporation must show proof that it is authorized to do business in the State of Florida. Florida corporations should provide copy of the Certificate of Incorporation and foreign corporations should provide copy of Certificate of Authority from the Florida Department of State.

INSURANCE

The successful bidder shall submit current general liability insurance and workers's compensation insurance certificates for the duration of the contract. Insurance companies must be authorized to do business in the State of Florida. Proof of such insurance shall be filed with the District Contracts and Procurement Office before the contract can be executed. BE SURE THAT THE CONTRACT NUMBER IS ON EACH INSURANCE CERTIFICATE.

ADDENDA

No negotiations, decisions, or actions will be initiated or executed by a potential bidder as a result of any oral discussion with a State employee. Only those communications which are in writing from the Department will be considered as a duly authorized expression on behalf of the Department. Notices of changes (addenda) will be posted on the District Six website at www.dot.state.fl.us/contractsadministrationdistrict6. Click on "Addenda", select the current year, and then select the applicable letting date. It is the responsibility of all potential bidders to monitor this site for any changing information prior to submitting their bid. **All addenda will be acknowledged by signature and subsequent submission of addenda with the bid when so stated in the addenda.**

NOTICE OF INTENT TO AWARD (POSTING NOTICE)

Unless bidders are notified by Fax transmission, express delivery, e-mail or certified mail, return receipt, the Department's intended award will be posted at the **Florida Department of Transportation, District Contracts and Procurement Office, Room 6203, 1000 Northwest 111 Avenue, Miami, Florida 33172, at 5:00 p.m. (EST), on June 2, 2008** and will remain posted for a period of seventy-two (72) hours. The Posting Notice will also be available on the District Six website at www.dot.state.fl.us/contractsadministrationdistrict6. Posting provides notice of the Department's intent to award a contract or to reject any or all bids.

RIGHT TO REJECT ANY OR ALL BIDS

Bidders are hereby notified that when bids for projects under \$250,000.00 are 15% under/above and for projects over \$250,000.00 are 10% under/above the Official Engineer's Estimate, the decision to award or reject must be made by the Awards Committee with appropriate minutes to document decisions. In the event any of the bids are rejected for this reason, the project may be deferred for re-advertising for bids until such time that a more competitive situation exists. In addition, award of all federally funded projects will be subject to Federal Highway Administration concurrence.

The Department reserves the right to reject any or all bids.

PROTEST RIGHTS: BID SOLICITATION / NON AWARD / CONTRACT AWARD

Pursuant to Florida Statutes, Section 337.11 (5)(a), any person who files an action protesting a bid solicitation, a bid rejection, or an award pursuant to this section shall post with the Department, at the time of filing a notice of protest, a bond payable to the Department in the following amounts:

1. For an action protesting a bid solicitation that requires qualification of bidders, the bond shall be \$5,000.
2. For an action protesting a bid rejection or contract award that requires qualification of bidders, the bond shall be equal to one percent of the lowest bid submitted or \$5,000, whichever is greater.
3. For an action protesting a bid solicitation, bid rejection, or contract award that does not require qualification of bidders, the bond shall be \$2,500.
 - (a) The bond required by this subsection shall be conditioned upon the payment of all costs which may be adjudged against the person filing the protest in the administrative hearing in which the action is brought and any subsequent appellate court proceeding. If, after completion of the administrative hearing process and any appellate court proceedings, the Department prevails, it shall recover all costs and charges which shall be included in the final order or judgment, excluding attorney's fees. Upon payment of such costs and charges by the person filing the protest, the bond shall be returned to him or her. If the person filing the protest prevails, he or she shall recover from the Department all costs and charges which shall be included in the final order or judgment, excluding attorney's fees. The entire amount of the bond shall be forfeited if the administrative law judge determines that a protest was filed for a frivolous or improper purpose, including, but not limited to, the purpose of harassing, causing unnecessary delay, or causing needless cost for the Department or parties.

- (b) As an alternative to any provision in Florida Statutes 120.57(3)(c), the Department may proceed with the bid solicitation or contract award process when the head of the Department sets forth in writing particular facts and circumstances which require the continuance of the bid solicitation process or the contract award process in order to avoid a substantial loss of funding to the state.
- (c) A person may not file a protest on any project for which he or she is not certified to bid pursuant to Florida Statutes 337.14.

The required notice of protest, bond and formal protest must each be timely filed with the Clerk of Agency Proceedings, Florida Department of Transportation, Mail Station 58, Room 550, Haydon Burns Building, 605 Suwannee Street, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-0458. Failure to file a protest within the time prescribed in Section 120.57(3), Florida Statutes, or failure to post the bond or other security required by law within the time allowed for filing a bond shall constitute a waiver of proceedings under Chapter 120, Florida Statutes. Call for bond forms and pertinent information.

A protest is not timely filed unless the notice of protest, bond, and the formal protest are each received by the Clerk of Agency Proceedings within the required time limits. A protest which is filed prematurely will be deemed abandoned unless timely renewed.

EXECUTION OF CONTRACT

Pursuant to Subsections 3-6 and 3-7 of the Standard Specifications, the successful bidder shall execute the necessary contract documents and return the agreement along with a satisfactory Performance and Payment Bond within twenty (20) calendar days of award unless noted otherwise in the project description.


