PROPOSAL REQUIREMENTS AND CONDITIONS.

(REV. 4-19-11)

ARTICLE 2-1 (of the Standard Maintenance Special Provisions) is deleted and the following substituted:

For this Project the Contractor is required to have specific expertise and experience in the performance of **Attenuator Repair & Installation**. In order for the Contractor to be responsive, the following must be submitted with the bid to the District Contract Administrator:

(a) A letter on the company letterhead with the following information (the letter must be signed by the Owner of the Company or Company Officer and dated):

- (1) A statement declaring at least **(3) complete years** of experience in the active performance of Attenuator Repair & Installation with its own forces and organization as opposed to the use of subcontractors. The company shall include up-to-date resumes for their Superintendents with experience in Attenuator Repair & Installation work.
- (2) A statement declaring that the company will perform all contract required Attenuator Repair & Installation with its own forces and organization, except as may be provided in Standard Specification 8-1 as modified by the Contract documents.
- (3) A statement listing project history of the company's experience as a Attenuator Repair & Installation contractor for the **(3) years** declared in item (a) (1) above, including the following information:
 - (i) Project name/number and brief description of Attenuator Repair & Installation performed; and
 - (ii) Beginning and ending date of Attenuator Repair & Installation contract; and
 - (iii) Location of project (city, state); and
 - (iv) Monetary amount of Attenuator Repair & Installation contract; and
 - (v) Owner of project/contact person/phone number with area code; and
 - (vi) If applicable, name of Prime Contractor (Client) that the work was performed for, including phone number with area code.

A Contractor presently prequalified with the Department in "N/A" will suffice to meet the above requirements.
