The Request for Proposal has been revised as follows:

- Page iii- ATTACHMENTS. Removed Attachment A-05 : Maintenance Requirements
- Page iv – REFERENCE DOCUMENTS. Added As-Built Lighting Plans and As-Built ITS plans to RD-0195: Concept Design
- Section I – Introduction. Added 4<sup>rd</sup> paragraph referencing elements that cannot be changed by ATC process (p. 1)
- Section II – Schedule of Events, Revised Schedule of Events Table to include ATC meeting, submittals and review and approval dates(p. 6)
- Section III – Threshold Requirements, Part H, deleted note #7 (p. 9)
- Section V, part B. Innovative Aspects, moved the list of “...Requirements of the Project that are not to be changed by the Design –Build Firms:” to Introduction on p. 1 (p. 14)
- Section V, part B. Innovative Aspects, sub section 1. Added “Alternative Technical Concept (ATC) Proposals” requirements. (p. 14-16)
- Section V, part Y. Maintenance Requirements, deleted entire section (p. 28)
- Section VI, Part M. Temporary Traffic Control Plan, revised last sentence in paragraph 1 to read “Existing ITS shall be maintained throughout the duration of construction”. (p. 40)

- Section VI, Part M. Temporary Traffic Control Plan, section 2 – Traffic control Restrictions, Added wording “Northbound and Southbound Express Lane markers may be removed between Sta 154+20 and 202+00 for the duration of the project. Express Lane markers must be restored to the their current configuration as part of final striping operations”. (p. 42)
- Section VI, Part M. Temporary Traffic Control Plan, revised allowable lane closures times (p. 43).
- Section VI, Part Q. Intelligent Transportation System Plans, Section 1, General. Revised table of anticipated features and details to reference front access type instead of walk in access. (p. 47-48).
