Sealed bids are requested for providing disaster-related emergency Cut & Toss and Debris Removal on the Florida Department of Transportation's Turnpike Enterprise. The contractor shall provide all equipment, labor, and materials necessary to "cut and toss" for clearing of the pavement area of the roadways including ramps, feeders and connector roads as described in Exhibit A - Scope of Services.

SPECIAL NOTES:

- No Bid Bond required
- No Pre-bid Conference
- Work will begin contingent upon legislative budget approval and availability of funds
- Awarded Contractor(s) must execute documents within five (5) work days; excluding weekends and state holidays
- Awarded Contractor(s) must provide and keep in force throughout the term of the contract General Liability and Workman's Compensation Insurance. The State of Florida Department of Transportation shall be endorsed as additional insured with regards to general liability insurance. Effective immediately, the Department will not accept insurance policies per this section that include commercial general liability coverage with a deductible, retention or self-insured retention feature. This does not include other insurance such as automobile, umbrella, or excess coverage that the contractor may also have obtained.
- Upon execution of the contract, the contractor must supply the Department with a letter from a surety authorized to do business in the State of Florida, verifying the contractor is bondable in the State of Florida in an amount equal to or greater than the amount of the original contract. The performance bond will be required when work is authorized.
