TALLAHASSEE, Fla. – Today, Governor Rick Scott announced three appointments and two reappointments to the Commission for the Transportation Disadvantaged.

Rebecca “Becki” Forsell, 66, of Tampa, is the executive director of Yes! of America United Inc. She succeeds Bryan Vaughn and is appointed for a term beginning May 1, 2016, and ending August 13, 2017.

Dr. Phillip Stevens, 51, of Lithia, is a division vice president for Jacobs Engineering. He fills a vacant seat and is appointed for a term beginning March 23, 2016, and ending August 13, 2018.

Dr. Robin D. Tellez, 59, of Miami, is the corporate director of culture and inclusion for Baptist Health South Florida. She succeeds Charlotte Temple and is appointed for a term beginning March 23, 2016, and ending August 13, 2017.

Marion Hart, 71, of Tallahassee, is a retired administrator with the Florida Department of Transportation. He is appointed as chair for a term beginning March 23, 2016, and ending August 13, 2019.

David “Mike” Willingham, 64, of Lake Placid, is the executive director of the Sebring Airport Authority. He is reappointed for a term beginning March 23, 2016, and ending August 13, 2017.
