Bidding Documents: Approvals for Design for LAP Projects

- ◆ *What is to be built?*
- ◆ *Which specifications does the Local Agency desire to use?*
- ◆ *Does this meet the requirements for on-system / off-system?*
- ◆ *What and who needs to review and approve?*
- ◆ *Will the work as shown in the bidding documents meet Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) requirements for reimbursement with federal funds?*



Where is the LAP project located and what requirements apply?

- ◆ On the State Highway System / National Highway System
- ◆ Off the State Highway System / On the Local Road System
- ◆ Off the State Highway System / National Highway System:
 - ✓ With bridge work, and/or
 - ✓ With box culvert work, and/or
 - ✓ Cost equal or greater than \$10 million (construction)

These “*Critical*” *Off-system* projects require additional analysis and planning to meet minimum established requirements.



On-system LAP Project Requirements

On the State Highway System / National Highway System

- ◆ Follow FDOT requirements
 - ✓ PPM
 - ✓ FDOT Standards
 - ✓ FDOT Specifications
- ◆ Reviewed by FDOT for compliance with FDOT requirements
- ◆ Handled the same as a FDOT let project



Off-system LAP Project Requirements

Off the State Highway System / On the Local Road System

- ◆ Follow Local Agency design parameters as long as federal requirements are met
 - ✓ Florida Greenbook
 - ✓ AASHTO Criteria
 - ✓ Local Agency's "Division I" Specifications (*General Requirements and Covenants*)
- ◆ Use Big Four Specifications for "Division II and Division III" Specifications - or - approved Local Agency Specifications (*for Construction Details and Materials*)



Off-system LAP Projects (continued)

Off the State Highway System / On the Local Road System

- ◆ Big Four Specifications for “Division II and Division III” cover:

- ✓ Embankment
- ✓ Asphalt
- ✓ Concrete
- ✓ Landscape



- ◆ Local Agency Specifications cover the remaining items of work
- ◆ FDOT Specifications may be used or referenced



“Critical” Off-system Project Requirements

Off the State Highway System / National Highway System

*With **bridge** work, **box culvert** work, and/or equal or greater than **\$10 million** (construction):*

- ◆ Follow on-system requirements:
 - ✓ FDOT Specifications (NOT Big Four or Local Specs)
 - ✓ Contract Administration per FDOT for Material Certification, testing and documentation



“Critical” Off-system Projects (continued)

Off the State Highway System / National Highway System

With **bridge** work, **box culvert** work, and/or equal or greater than **\$10 million** (construction):

- ◆ Follow Local Agency design parameters as long as federal requirements are met
 - ✓ Florida Greenbook
 - ✓ AASHTO Criteria
 - ✓ Local Agency’s “Division I” Specifications (*General Requirements and Covenants*)



“Critical” Off-system Projects (continued)

Off the State Highway System / National Highway System

With **bridge** work and/or **box culvert** work:

- ◆ Critical Components Methodology
 - ✓ Only apply “critical” project requirements to bridges and box culverts
 - ✓ FDOT certifies materials for “critical” component work and Local Agency certifies other work
 - ✓ Inspection qualifications (field and lab testing) for “critical” component work per FDOT requirements
 - ✓ Plan set and Specifications clearly depict what qualifications shall apply for “critical” work and other work

Welcome

The Department contracts with other governmental agencies to develop, design, acquire right-of-way, and construct transportation facilities and to reimburses these agencies for services provided to the traveling public. When a Local Agency is to be reimbursed using Federal funds administered by the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), the Department is held accountable to ensure that the Agency complied with all applicable Federal statutes, rules and regulations. Local Agencies must be LAP-certified before entering into a LAP Agreement.

The Local Agency Program (LAP) is administered in each District by a District LAP Administrator designated by the District Secretary. Project-level direction and oversight are provided through the District Offices of Planning, Environmental Management, Design, Right-of-Way, Policy Planning, Environmental Management, Federal-Aid, Design, Contracts Administration, Equal Opportunity, Comptroller, and Program Development. The Central Office LAP Administrator chairs the standing committee on standards and practices for local agencies.

FHWA has developed a document titled the *Guide to Federal-Aid Programs and Projects*. This guide provides basic information about the Federal-Aid programs, projects, and other program information such as funding share, regulatory reference, background and history. The guide is intended to provide basic information for FHWA and State personnel involved in the administration of the Federal-Aid Highway Program. This guide should be of interest to FHWA, State highway agencies, local governments, and private sector personnel interested in a basic understanding of Federal-Aid programs, projects, or other program characteristics.

Subject: Local Agency Program Critical Components

This bulletin clarifies the requirements of chapter 23.1.3 of the LAP Manual which requires, that in addition to projects on the national and state highway system, the projects (referred to as critical projects) shown below will be administered in accordance with the *FDOT Construction Project Administration Manual (Topic No. 700-000-000)*. Materials will be inspected in accordance with the *FDOT Sampling Testing and Reporting Guide by Material Description and the FDOT Materials Manual (Topic No. 875-000-000)*. FDOT Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction (including all modifications such as supplemental and special provisions) must be used. The Local Agency will be responsible for all project level inspection, verification testing, and assuring all data are entered into LIMS.

Critical Projects

- All LAP bridge projects.
- Box Culverts, and
- All projects with a construction value of \$10 million or more including road widening.

In the case of an off system project where the work mix includes items beyond a bridge and a box culvert (referred to as critical components), the Local Agencies will have the option of applying the above requirements to the critical components only. The other work items may use Local Agency specifications approved by the Central Office.

The dollar threshold and requirements for prequalified contractors and construction and engineering inspection remain in effect. Other impacts to projects using critical components:

- For the Laboratory Information Management System (LIMS), data entry for sampling and testing is only required for the work related to the critical component(s).
- For the Material Certification responsibilities, the Department will certify only the work for the critical component(s), and the local agency will certify the non-critical work.
- For the Construction Engineering and Inspection (CEI), construction oversight and acceptance activities, the CEI work related to the critical component(s) is to be accomplished with personnel which hold the appropriate Department qualifications related to the critical component work.

FDOT "Specs on the Web"

A new online tool to help Local Agencies compile specifications for contract documents

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) now has a new resource available to Local Agencies for compiling specifications for contract documents.

"Specs on the Web" is an online application used by FDOT staff and consultants to assemble the specifications for a contract. The application has been enhanced to provide easy access for Local Agencies to download specifications in Microsoft Word format. The files may be downloaded to a local computer and used to develop the Local Agency contract specification documents.

Specification files include:

- "The Big Four" — Earthwork, asphalt, concrete, and landscape specifications approved for use on Federally funded off-system projects
- **FDOT Archive Specifications** — Asphalt, base, earthwork, and concrete specifications no longer in use on the State Highway System
- **Supplemental Specifications** — Implemented changes to the Standard Specifications
- **2013 Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction**

To access the application, visit the FDOT Specifications Office website (www.dot.state.fl.us/specificationsoffice) and click on the "Specs on the Web" link located in the icon bar at the top of the page (see illustration above). There is no login required; just click on the Local Agency Specs link (as shown below).

Local Agency Program (LAP) :

- On the State Highway System (On-System) LAP projects must use Divisions II and III of the FDOT Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction and implemented modifications in accordance with the LAP Manual.
- Off-System LAP projects must use the pre-approved Big 4 Specifications or local agency specifications approved in advance in accordance with the LAP Manual.

Off-System LAP Specifications ("Big 4")	The "Big 4" Specifications were developed in conjunction with the Florida Green Book Committee, our Local Agency Program (LAP) partners, the Florida Association of County Engineers and Road Superintendents (FACERS), and the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA).

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Track the Status of Proposed Revisions

Revisions to the published Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction may be implemented to enhance safety, reduce costs, comply with new laws, rules or policies; incorporate new technology; update industry standards or practices, and other critical updates. Specs on the Web

Design/Build **Design Build** Specifications boilerplate to be incorporated into the Request for Proposal (RFP) for Design Build projects.

Local Agency Specs Implemented specifications used by **Local Agencies**.

Developmental Specs **Developmental Specifications** are developed around a new process, procedure, or material approved for limited use by the State Specifications and Estimates Office. These specifications are signed and sealed by the professional engineer responsible for authorizing use and monitoring performance in the field. Developmental Specifications are requested from the District Specifications Office on a project by project basis.

Push Button **Push Button Specifications** allow the use of Work Documents or Task Orders to complete the work covered by the contract.

Maintenance Specifications Specifications developed for use on **Maintenance Contracts**.
