

The exact nature and extent of the reporting requirements and format for data collection are not fully known at this time but will be provided by the Department when made available by the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA). These projects are pending Federal Funds approval and FDOT authorization. Project Description: The Department intends to construct a new bridge over the South Fork of the St. Lucie River (Indian Street Bridge) which connects Palm City to Stuart. This project includes but is not limited to widening and reconstruction of South West 36 Street from west of Mapp Road to the river. Widening of the intersections at Mapp Road and Kanner Highway (SR 76) at Indian Street. Two signalized intersections with mast arms. New drainage system installation. New decorative lighting system. Landscaping with irrigation.

Project Description: This project involves the realignment of Dixie Highway from south of Hillsboro Boulevard (SR-810) to north of the Broward / Palm Beach County line. The project begins as a 4-lane urban arterial roadway with bicycle lanes, and sidewalk on both sides of Dixie Highway. The Florida East Coast (FEC) Railway parallels the roadway immediately to the east. Just north of the Hillsboro Boulevard intersection, the proposed 4-lane alignment raises vertically and becomes an elevated structure over NE 2nd Street, NE 1st Avenue, North River Avenue, FEC Railroad tracks, NE 2nd Avenue, and the Hillsboro Canal. Once the elevated structure crosses over the Hillsboro Canal and enters Palm Beach County, the alignment ties back down to existing grades and transitions to a 5-lane section. There are also 2 other bridge structures proposed for this project. There will be a pedestrian path that runs along the east side of the corridor, and crosses over the Hillsboro Canal. Also crossing the Canal is a ramp alignment for southbound traffic coming from Dixie Highway One signalized intersection with mast arms. New drainage system installation. New decorative lighting system. Landscaping with irrigation.

Project Description: The design and construction of the Express Lanes which with varying widening will convert the existing High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV) Lane into 2 Express Lanes along Interstate 95 from a point north of the SR 826 Golden Glades Interchange to a point south of the Broward Boulevard Park & Ride. The Design Build Firm will be responsible for analyzing and designing all roadway and structural elements in addition to, but not limited to drainage, storm water management, traffic control, permitting, utility coordination, lighting, Intelligent Transportation Systems infrastructure, survey, geotechnical investigations, signing, pavement markings and FHWA re-evaluations.

Additionally, the project will include a 10' wide asphalt shared use path along the canal bank. This project includes alternate bid items to receive bids on both flexible asphalt pavement and rigid concrete pavement options.

Design Build: Design Build contracts are acquired by advertisement for Letters of Interest from pre-qualified firms. A Pre-qualified Contractor teams with a Pre-qualified Design Firm (or vice versa) to submit a letter of interest in response to the criteria outlined in the advertisement. Letters are reviewed and a Long List is compiled in order of ranking according to the response to the criteria noted in the letter. The Long List is presented to the Selection Committee who then Short Lists no less than 3 firms. The short listed firms receive a Request for Proposal (RFP) from the Department that outlines the project criteria. The firms then develop a Technical Proposal and submit it to the Department. The technical proposal is evaluated and scored based on the criteria outlined in the RFP. The firms also submit a Price Proposal. District Four uses an adjusted score method to determine the awarded contractor. Adjusted score is obtained by dividing the price proposal by the technical proposal score. Award is made to the Contractor with the lowest responsive adjusted score. Advertisement for design build projects are on the web site <http://www.dot.state.fl.us/procurement/>. Construction & Maintenance Contracts: District Contracts are acquired by advertisement for bids for road and bridge construction and maintenance projects. Award is to the responsive low bidder. Advertisements are listed under the Letting dates for District Four at: www.dot.state.fl.us/cc-admin. There is no prequalification for maintenance contract. For all construction projects with a budget estimate over \$250,000 the Contractor must be pre-qualified. **For prequalification information**, access www.dot.state.fl.us/cc-admin from "Office Menu", select "Prequalification Information". **To receive monthly advertisements and updates** for all Districts and Central Office, access www.dot.state.fl.us/cc-admin select BSN "Subscribe to Contracts Administration BSN Subscription" and complete the requested information.
