All specifications are taken from the 2000 United States Census. In 2000, the population of Walton County was 46,400. There are 1,268 square miles in the county.

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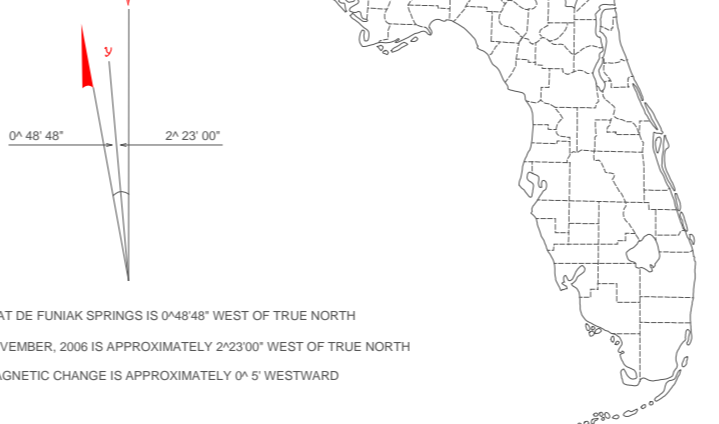
