City populations are taken from the U.S. Census for 2000. In 2000 the population of St. Johns County was 123,135. There are 617 square miles in the county.

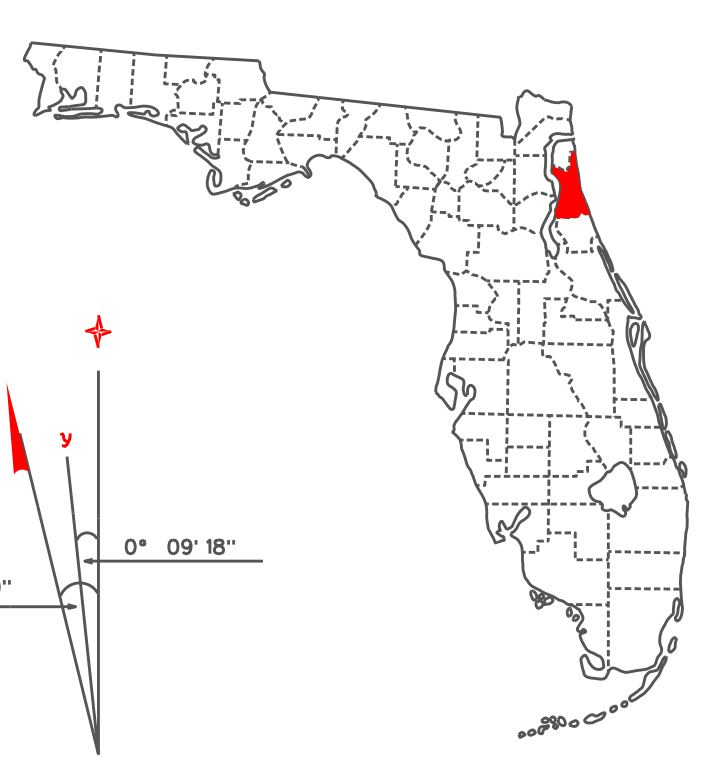

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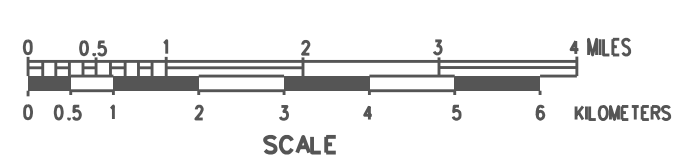
