I-75 from north of CR 951/Collier Boulevard (mile marker 101) to just north of Golden Gate Parkway (mile marker 105): Construction project: FDOT would like to announce early completion of the project to widen I-75 to six lanes from CR 951/Collier Boulevard to just north of Golden Gate Parkway. Originally estimated to be complete in early 2017, FDOT's project team (Kinard Stone Transportation Engineering & Consulting, Inc. and Ajax Paving Industries of Florida, Inc.) finished the project approximately four months (130 days) early. As of the most recent estimate, the project is under the \$31.9 million budget.

"FDOT is excited to announce that we were able to finish this important project under budget and months ahead of schedule. This project completes the widening of I-75 from Alligator Alley to the Lee/Charlotte County line. These improvements will make it easier of our citizens, seasonal residents and visitors to continue to enjoy all that Collier County and Southwest Florida has to offer." said FDOT District One Secretary Billy Hattaway, P.E.

With the completion of this project, I-75 provides motorists with six travel lanes from CR 951/Collier Boulevard north through Lee County to the Charlotte County line. This project also built an inside 10-foot shoulder and noise barriers from south of the Golden Gate Canal to north of Golden Gate High School on both sides of the roadway.
