U.S. 17 resurfacing project begins Monday

Palatka – Five miles of U.S. 17, from Feagle Avenue in Pomona Park to County Road 309 in Satsuma, will be improved and resurfaced starting next week.

The project includes the installation of left turn lanes at the Dollar General Store, Sisco Road and Kingston Boulevard, extending the sidewalk from Lake Street to Greenville Avenue, drainage upgrades and new highway signage.

In addition, a roadway depression located north of Kingston Boulevard will be corrected. During this phase of construction, lanes in the area will be reduced to 11 feet to accommodate the installation of a barrier wall.

Drivers should expect daily daytime and nighttime lane closures for the duration of the project, however, no lane closures will be scheduled from 6:30 a.m. to 9:30 a.m., or from 3:30 p.m. to 7 p.m., Monday through Friday.

Halifax Paving, Inc., of Jacksonville, is the contractor. The Florida Department of Transportation's (FDOT) \$3.2 million project is expected to be complete in fall 2016.
