### **I-10 lane closures west of Marietta exit scheduled Wednesday and Thursday nights**

*Jacksonville, FL* – Eastbound lanes of Interstate 10 west of Exit 355 (Marietta) are scheduled to close Wednesday at 9 p.m. and reopen Thursday by 5 a.m. and westbound lanes are scheduled to close Thursday at 9 p.m. and reopen Friday by 5 a.m. Contractors will be installing bridge fences over I-10 for the Marietta interchange project, weather permitting.

Traffic will be detoured around the work areas on the new eastbound and westbound on- and off-ramps at Hammond Boulevard. The on- and off-ramps will be opened temporarily for the detour and will reopen permanently at the completion of the project.

The \$26.9 million Florida Department of Transportation's (FDOT) I-10 Marietta interchange project began October 2013 and is scheduled for completion in summer 2016. It replaces the current Exit 355 located 0.8 miles east and connects Hammond Boulevard over I-10. Superior Construction of Jacksonville is the project contractor.

### **On-ramp to I-75 South from Northwest 39<sup>th</sup> Avenue closed Wednesday night** *I-75 North off-ramp to U.S. 441 at Exit 399 scheduled to reopen*

*Gainesville, FL* – The on-ramp to I-75 South from Northwest 39<sup>th</sup> Avenue (State Road 222-Exit 390) is scheduled to completely close to traffic at 11 p.m. Wednesday, weather permitting, to set barrier wall for upcoming construction. The ramp will reopen by 5 a.m. Thursday.

Additionally, the I-75 North off-ramp to U.S. 441 at Exit 399 is scheduled to reopen by 6 a.m. Thursday. The ramp has been continuously closed since April 10 for pavement reconstruction.

During the Northwest 39<sup>th</sup> Avenue southbound on-ramp closure, traffic will detour nine miles north to Exit 399 at U.S. 441 to enter I-75 South.

The work is part of the \$23 million project to resurface 12 miles of I-75 from Northwest 39<sup>th</sup> Avenue to U.S. 441 and improve the Northwest 39<sup>th</sup> Avenue and U.S. 441 interchanges in Alachua County is scheduled for completion this fall.

We appreciate your patience during this construction to maintain Northeast Florida's interstate infrastructure. Of the 50 million people who travel by car into Florida, 40 million travel through District Two.

## **State Road 100 east of Starke closing at railroad crossing Monday**

*3.5-mile detour in place during 5-day closure for crossing replacement*

*Starke* – State Road 100 (East Madison Street) will completely close and all traffic detoured in the immediate area of the railroad crossing north of County Road 100A in Bradford County for five days beginning Monday at 9 a.m. The road is scheduled to reopen by 5 p.m. Friday, May 6, weather permitting.

During the closure, a 3.5-mile detour will be in place. Traffic will use State Road 100, U.S. 301 and Southeast 144<sup>th</sup> Street during the closure.

Law enforcement officers will assist with the closure and detour. The roadway will reopen early if work is completed ahead of schedule or could possibly be closed longer if there are weather delays.

The existing one-track railroad crossing, operated by Camp Blanding, is being replaced with a new concrete crossing designed to last longer under heavy traffic. The crossing area will also be resurfaced. Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is overseeing the project.

Rail is an important component of a healthy economy. It is a cost effective way to move people and goods efficiently, ultimately saving companies and people money. Rail is also a part of Florida's Strategic Intermodal System (SIS).
