## **FDOT to hold Corridor Alternatives Meeting on Santa Rosa Sound Alternate Crossing Study**

---

**Chipley** – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will hold a Corridor Alternatives public meeting concerning the Santa Rosa Sound Alternate Crossing Study in Okaloosa County. The meeting will be held Tuesday, Sept. 20 from 5:30 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. CST at the Emerald Coast Convention Center, 1250 Miracle Strip Parkway, S.E., Fort Walton Beach.

The study is evaluating the feasibility for an alternate road and bridge corridor between Fort Walton Beach and Okaloosa Island. The intent of this meeting is to present to the public and officials the preliminary results from the evaluation conducted on 10 potential corridors. Public input received will be incorporated in the final corridor report and will be used to help identify study recommendations.

The meeting will be held in an open-house format and will include an informational video; there will be no formal presentation. Representatives from FDOT will be available to explain proposed improvements, answer questions and receive comments.
