Kick-Off Meeting on U.S. 90 Project Development and Environment Study

Chipley, FL –The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will hold a public kick-off meeting concerning the Project Development and Environment (PD&E) Study for widening of U.S. 90 (State Road 10) from the current four-lane roadway to a six-lane roadway and intersection improvements beginning at Scenic Highway in Escambia County and continuing to Glover Lane in Santa Rosa County. The meeting will be held Thursday, Jan. 28 from 5:30 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. CST at the Santa Rosa County Auditorium, 4530 Spikes Way, Milton.

The intent of this study is to document viable alternatives and typical sections, evaluate the stormwater management needs, as well as to assess socio-economic and environmental impacts for each alternative. There will be no formal presentation; however, maps, drawings and other study information will be on display. FDOT representatives will be available to answer questions and receive comments.
