Traffic Shift on U.S. 90 over Yellow River Bridge Rescheduled

Chipley– Due to inclement weather conditions the traffic shift originally scheduled to take place tonight on U.S. 90 over Yellow River in Okaloosa County has been rescheduled. Eastbound traffic will be transitioned to the newly constructed eastbound span Saturday, April 16 at 6 p.m. Drivers may encounter intermittent lane restrictions throughout the day as crews make preparations for the shift.

All activities are weather dependent and may be delayed or rescheduled in the event of inclement weather. Motorists are reminded to use caution, especially at night, when traveling in a work zone and to watch for construction workers and equipment entering and exiting the roadway.
