CHARLOTTE COUNTY

I-75 from south of Harborview Drive (mile marker #167) to Sumter Boulevard (mile marker #182): Construction project: This project widens the road from four to six lanes and adds a 12-foot travel lane and 10-foot shoulder to the inside of existing northbound and southbound I-75. Work begins with installation of construction signs and silt fence for erosion control.

- **Yorkshire Street will reopen on Thursday, March 17, weather permitting**
- **Motorists should expect Raintree Street to close temporarily for the next several months at the I-75 overpass on Thursday, March 17, weather permitting. Motorists should follow detour signs**
- **Motorists should expect the northbound off-ramp closed at Toledo Blade Boulevard during the nighttime/overnight hours from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. on Tuesday, March 15, weather permitting. Motorists should follow detour signs**
- **Motorists should expect the northbound off-ramp closed at Sumter Boulevard during the nighttime/overnight hours from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. on Thursday, March 17, weather permitting. Motorists should follow detour signs**
- **Motorists should expect the northbound on-ramp closed at Sumter Boulevard during the nighttime/overnight hours from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. on Sunday, March 20, weather permitting. Motorists should follow detour signs**

Variable message signs will be in place to alert drivers that work is underway. Drivers should use caution while traveling in this area. Estimated completion is end of 2017. The contractor is Astaldi Construction Corporation.
