## RoadWatch Advisory

### CHARLOTTE COUNTY

**US 41 from Charlotte County Line to Morningside Drive:** Construction project: Crews will be widening northbound shoulders and resurfacing the roadway. This project also includes updating signage and pavement markings. Work occurs during daytime and nighttime hours. **Motorists should expect intermittent northbound lane closures through the duration of the project.**

- **Motorists should expect a traffic shift beginning at 10 p.m. Friday, July 31 for crews to remove concrete from the southbound travel lanes, weather permitting.** Southbound and northbound traffic will now use northbound travel lanes. Motorists exiting driveways and side streets in this area should use caution, as traffic is now shifted to the eastside of the roadway.

Drivers should use caution traveling in this area. Estimated completion is early 2016. The Contractor is Ajax Paving Industries of Florida, LLC.
