Open House Scheduled for State Road 9B Extension into St. Johns County

Saint Johns – Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) invites the community to an open house Thursday, August 20 to learn more about the State Road 9B extension from I-95 to County Road 2209 (St. Johns Parkway) that will be starting soon.

The open house is from 4:30-6:30 p.m. at Creekside Christian Church located at 92 Life Spring Way in Saint Johns. Construction project engineers and FDOT representatives will be available to speak with the community about questions, concerns and general information. No formal presentation will be given. The open house format allows for interested parties to stop by anytime between 4:30 and 6:30 p.m. to ask questions.

FDOT hired Superior Construction Company Southeast of Jacksonville to construct the \$79.7 million State Road 9B extension project. It is scheduled to begin in mid-August and finish by summer 2018. The final segment of State Road 9B extends 2.3 miles from I-95 to County Road 2209 and includes new interchanges at Peyton Parkway (Race Track Road Connector) and County Road 2209. The new Peyton Parkway connector road will provide direct access to and from Race Track Road to State Road 9B. For more details visit www.SR9B.com.



Jacksonville Area Road and Lane Closures for August 15-21, 2015

Clay County

County Road 218 between Mimosa and Carnation avenues in Middleburg

Daytime lane closures weekdays from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. for concrete, drainage work and to install signs.

Trail Ridge Road at State Road 23

Nighttime lane closures from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. from Discovery Drive to Challenger Drive for cleanup work.

U.S. 301 between the Bradford and Duval County lines

Daytime lane closures for paving and drainage work.

Duval County

I-10 at State Road 23/Cecil Commerce Center Parkway

Continuous westbound off-ramp lane closures in preparation for building new interchange. Also nighttime lane closures Monday and Tuesday from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. to install barrier wall.

I-10 from Lane Avenue to Cassat Avenue

Nighttime eastbound lane closures tonight through Thursday from 9:30 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. for concrete work in the median as part of the widening project.

I-95 from south of Bowden Road to Butler Boulevard

Nighttime weekday southbound lane closures from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. for overpass construction.

I-95 at Butler Boulevard ramp

Nighttime southbound off-ramp lane closures Saturday through Thursday from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. for drainage work.

I-95 from County Road 210 to Philips Highway

Daytime closures of southbound emergency lane from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. for installing Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) equipment.

I-95 from County Road 210 to Race Track Road

Nighttime northbound lane closures Monday and Tuesday from 9:30 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. to install sign foundation.

I-95 from County Road 210 to Old St. Augustine Road

Nighttime northbound road closure Wednesday from midnight to 5 a.m. to install overhead signs. Detour is eastbound County Road 210, northbound U.S. 1 to westbound Old St. Augustine Road.

I-95 from south of Greenland Road to south of Butler Boulevard

Nighttime lane closures Sunday through Friday from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. and periodic nighttime on and off-ramp closures weeknights at Baymeadows Road, Philips Highway and Southside Boulevard to install traffic signal sensors in pavement and to replace guardrails. Follow detour route.

I-95 from north of the rest area at County Road 210 to south of Old St. Augustine Road

Nighttime southbound lane closures Monday through Thursday from 8 p.m. to 6:30 a.m. for State Road 9B road construction.

I-95 from Myrtle Avenue to Golfair Boulevard

Nighttime lane and ramp closures from 7:30 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. to install guardrail, signs, traffic signal sensors in pavement and paint road markings. Follow detour routes.

I-95 from Old St. Augustine Road to Race Track Road

Nighttime southbound lane closures Wednesday and Thursday from 8 p.m. to 7 a.m. for drainage work.

I-95 Overland Bridge between Fuller Warren Bridge and Emerson Street

Nighttime southbound road closure beginning half a mile south of the Fuller Warren bridge Tuesday through Thursday from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. for bridge construction. Detour is I-95 southbound access road.

Continuous lane closure of the I-95 southbound access road to Atlantic Boulevard weekdays for roadway construction.

Nighttime closure of San Diego Road from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. for bridge construction. Eastbound detour is Martin Street, Philips Highway, Atlantic Boulevard, White Avenue to San Diego Road. Westbound detour is Spring Park Road, Atlantic Boulevard, Philips Highway, Wishart Street to San Diego Road

New southbound ramp to Atlantic Boulevard off-ramp is open. The ramp is located a half-mile north of the existing ramp. Motorists traveling south across the I-95 Fuller Warren Bridge will use the right lane to exit onto the new Atlantic Boulevard ramp. The two left lanes will continue

south on I-95. Downtown traffic coming from the Acosta and Main Street bridges will continue using the left lane of the I-95 southbound service road to exit onto the new Atlantic Boulevard ramp. The two right lanes will continue to southbound I-95.

Nighttime lane closures from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. from Park Avenue to Atlantic Boulevard for road work.

Nighttime weeknight lane closures from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. on Atlantic Boulevard between Kings Avenue and Old Hickory Road for drainage work.

Continuous lane closures on Gary Street between Palm Avenue and San Marco Boulevard for bridge construction.

The existing access from northbound Philips Highway to Atlantic Boulevard is closed for approximately three months. Detour is Kings Avenue which has been modified to provide two-way travel between Philips Highway and Atlantic Boulevard.

The southbound I-95 ramp to Philips Highway is closed for approximately three months. Detour to Emerson Street exit (Exit 347).

Nighttime road closure of the I-95 southbound access road from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. for roadway construction. Detours are Acosta Bridge to Prudential Drive, Kings Avenue, Philips Highway, Emerson Street to I-95; Main Street Bridge to Museum Circle, Prudential Drive, Kings Avenue, Philips Highway, Emerson Street to I-95; Museum Circle westbound to San Marco Boulevard, Prudential Drive, Kings Avenue, Philips Highway, Emerson Street to I-95; Prudential Drive to Kings Avenue, Philips Highway, Emerson Street to I-95.

Nighttime westbound road closures Friday through Sunday (August 23) from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. on Atlantic Boulevard from Kings Avenue to Gary Street for bridge construction. Follow detour route.

There will be no scheduled lane closures on I-95, Atlantic Boulevard, Hendricks Avenue, Kings Avenue, Main Street or San Marco Boulevard from today at 4:30 p.m. through Saturday at 12:30 a.m. for the Jacksonville Jaguars football game.

I-95 over Spring Glen Road

Nighttime lane closures Sunday through Wednesday from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. for routine overpass maintenance.

I-295 East Beltway from I-95 to Atlantic Boulevard

Daytime weekday lane closures of emergency lanes from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. for installing Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) equipment.

I-295 East Beltway just north of Baymeadows Road

Nighttime lane closures Sunday through Wednesday from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. for routine overpass maintenance.

I-295 East Beltway at Baymeadows Road

Daytime weekday lane closures of emergency lanes from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. for installing Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) equipment.

I-295 East Beltway at Beach Boulevard

Daytime weekday lane closures of emergency lanes from 7 a.m. to 4 p.m. for installing Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) equipment.

I-295 East Beltway at Butler Boulevard

Butler Boulevard at I-95

Complete closure Wednesday from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. for placement of overpass deck.

Westbound detour is I-95 northbound to Bowden Road (Exit 345) and make a u-turn at Bowden Road back on to I-95 southbound. Eastbound detour is I-95 southbound to Baymeadows Road (Exit 343) and make a u-turn at Baymeadows Road back on to I-95 northbound. Philips Highway will also be used as an alternate route.

Nighttime eastbound on-ramp closure to southbound I-95 weeknights from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. for ramp construction. Detour is I-95 north to Bowden Road (Exit 345) to I-95 south.

Nighttime westbound on-ramp closure to southbound I-95 Sunday through Thursday from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. to unload construction materials. Detour is Philips Highway, Baymeadows Road to I-95.

Nighttime lane closures Saturday through Thursday from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. from Philips Highway to I-95 to deliver construction materials and overpass work.

Hart Expressway over Beach Boulevard

Daytime lane closures Thursday from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. for routine overpass maintenance.

Heckscher Drive at Sisters Creek Bridge

Daytime lane closures Saturday from 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. and Monday through Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. for construction of a retaining wall and pile driving.

Kings Avenue at Nira Street

Daytime lane closures Wednesday from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. to paint road markings.

Lem Turner Road over Trout River

Nighttime lane closures Sunday through Wednesday from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. for routine bridge maintenance.

Main Street at Ocean Street

Daytime northbound lane closure Saturday from 8 a.m. to noon to install a barrier wall and signs.

Martin Luther King Jr. Parkway over Jessie Street

Daytime road closure Saturday from 9 to 10 a.m. for JEA to install overhead power lines. Jacksonville Sheriff's Office will assist with detours.

Martin Luther King Jr. Parkway over Pearl Street

Nighttime lane closures Sunday through Wednesday from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. for routine overpass maintenance.

Owens Road between Yankee Clipper Drive and Fair Pine Lane

The road is completely closed for road construction. Detour is Owens Road to Ranch Road to Airport Service Road North.

Philips Highway from University Boulevard to south of I-95

Daytime lane closures Monday through Saturday (August 22) from 7 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. and nighttime lane closures Sunday through Saturday (August 22) from 8 p.m. to 7 a.m. for signal, repaving and concrete work.

Pritchard Road at I-295 West Beltway

Nighttime lane closures Sunday through Thursday from 7:30 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. and nighttime on and off-ramp closures Sunday through Thursday from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. to paint road markings. Follow detour routes.

R.G. Skinner Parkway at State Road 9B

Nighttime lane closures tonight and Saturday from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. to remove barrier walls.

San Jose Boulevard between Hartley and Plummer Cove roads

Nighttime lane closures Sunday through Friday from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. to install temporary barrier wall and paint road markings.

San Jose Boulevard at I-295 West Beltway

Nighttime southbound closure of on-ramp Sunday through Friday from 11 p.m. to 3 a.m. to paint road markings. Proceed to Claire Lane and make a u-turn to head back to I-295 West Beltway southbound on-ramp.

State Road 23/Cecil Commerce Center Parkway from Argyle Forest Boulevard to 103rd Street

Nighttime northbound lane closures Sunday through Friday from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. for paving.

State Road 23/Cecil Commerce Center Parkway from New World Avenue to Normandy Boulevard

Nighttime northbound lane closures Sunday through Friday from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. for paving.

State Road 23/Cecil Commerce Center Parkway from Normandy Boulevard to 103rd Street

Nighttime road closure Saturday through Tuesday from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. for overpass work. Follow detour route.

State Road 23/Cecil Commerce Center Parkway at New World Avenue

Nighttime lane closures from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. for overpass work.

State Road 23/Cecil Commerce Center Parkway north and south of Argyle Forest Boulevard

Nighttime lane closures Saturday through Saturday (August 22) from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. to install barrier walls for traffic shift and install overhead gantry.

Timuquana Road at Roosevelt Boulevard railroad crossing

The road is closed through Sunday for railroad crossing replacement. Westbound detour is Roosevelt Boulevard, San Juan Avenue to Blanding Boulevard. Eastbound detour is Blanding Boulevard, San Juan Avenue to Roosevelt Boulevard.

Union Street at Ocean Street

Daytime and nighttime eastbound lane closures Friday from 7 p.m. to 3 a.m. and Saturday from 8 a.m. to Sunday 6 a.m. for JEA utility work.

University Boulevard over Arlington River Bridge

Daytime lane closures at the bridge to unload construction materials.

Wonderwood Drive from Longleaf Pine Way to Gately Road

Daytime lane closures Saturday and Sunday from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. and nighttime lane closures from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. for drainage work.

Wonderwood Drive over Ginhouse Creek Bridge

All traffic is shifted to the eastbound bridge for approximately three weeks for work on the westbound approach at the bridge.

Nassau County**State Road A1A from Still Quarters Road to U.S. 17 in Yulee**

Traffic is shifted onto temporary lanes from Ruben Davis Lane to the CSX railroad crossing west of U.S. 17.

U.S. 1 from the Duval County line to Fifth Avenue in Callahan

Daytime lane closures from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. for paving and to paint road markings.

U.S. 301 over the railroad tracks in Callahan

Daytime lane closures Monday from 9:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. for routine overpass maintenance.

U.S. 301 north of Baldwin to south of Callahan

All lanes are open to traffic from north of Baldwin to Callahan. Daytime lane closures from 8:30 a.m. to 6 p.m. for cleanup.
