I-95 northbound nightly detours scheduled

Jacksonville – I-95 northbound lanes from County Road 210 to Old St. Augustine Road are scheduled to close Monday through Thursday from midnight to 5 a.m. Northbound I-95 traffic is detoured to County Road 210, U.S. 1 and Old St. Augustine Road.

The closures will allow for the installation of overhead sign structures for the State Road 9B project, weather permitting.

The second phase of State Road 9B, connecting U.S. 1 to I-95, began in April 2013 and is expected to be complete by summer 2016. For more details visit www.SR9B.com.

FDOT Road and Lane Closures February 6-12, 2016

St. Augustine --- The following is a list of roadwork underway by FDOT that may impact traffic in Putnam and St. Johns counties.

Putnam County

U.S. 17

Daytime lane closures Saturday through Friday from 7 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. from State Road 100 to Horse Landing Road for the four-lane widening project.

State Road 20

Daytime lane closures Monday and Tuesday from 9:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. over Rice Creek for routine bridge maintenance.

St. Johns County

County Road 2209

Lanes are reduced to one way in each direction from Russell Sampson Road to a mile north of County Road 210 for State Road 9B construction. Lane reductions will be in place for the duration of the project.

State Road 13

Daytime lane closures weekdays from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. from Fruit Cove Road to Race Track Road for pavement repairs.

I-95 from County Road 210 to Old St. Augustine Road

Nighttime northbound lane closures Monday through Thursday from 7 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. and southbound lane closures Monday and Tuesday from 8 p.m. to 7 a.m. There will be a nighttime northbound road closure Monday through Thursday from midnight to 5 a.m. to install overhead structures and signs for State Road 9B. Detour is County Road 210, Philips Highway, Old St. Augustine Road to I-95 northbound.

U.S.1/Philips Highway

Nighttime lane closures tonight at 7 p.m. through Sunday at 7 p.m. from Race Track Road to State Road 9B for paving.

FDOT Road and Lane Closures for February 6-12, 2016

ALACHUA COUNTY

Interstate 75 Up to two lanes closed nightly in each direction Sunday through Friday from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. just north of Archer Road (Exit 384) for construction of the Celebration Pointe (Southwest 30th Avenue) overpass.

Interstate 75 Daytime lane closures and emergency lane closures Monday through Thursday from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. from north of U.S. 441 to the Columbia County line for resurfacing.

Interstate 75 Nighttime lane closures Sunday through Thursday from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. from south of Northwest 39th Avenue (Exit 390) to north of U.S. 441 (Exit 399) in Alachua for resurfacing. Also, daytime closures of the emergency lanes Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. for drainage work

Interstate 75 Inside lane closures reducing traffic to a two-lane traffic shift at the Santa Fe River Bridge at the Alachua/Columbia County line for bridge work. The speed limit is reduced to 55 mph.

Interstate 75 Daytime northbound lane closures of- the emergency lane north of Archer Road (State Road 24) to the Columbia County line to install fiber optic and pull boxes along the shoulders.

Newberry Road Nighttime lane closures Sunday through Thursday from 8:30 p.m. to 6 a.m. from west of I-75 to Southwest 38th Street for sidewalk and drainage work.

Northwest 13th Street Possible nighttime southbound lane closures Monday and Tuesday just north of University Avenue for driveway modifications at The Standard.

Northwest 39th Avenue Daytime westbound lane closures from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. between Interstate 75 and Northwest 43rd Street to repair sidewalks.

Northwest 39th Avenue Daytime eastbound lane closures from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. at Northwest 46th Terrace for roadway testing.

U.S. 301 Daytime lane closures from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. in Waldo to repair concrete drainage inlets.

U.S. 441 North Daytime northbound lane closures from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. between Alachua and High to repair ditches.

U.S. 441 South Daytime northbound lane closures from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. between Gainesville and Micanopy to clean ditches.

Waldo Road Daytime lane closures from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. in Waldo to repair concrete drainage inlets.

COLUMBIA COUNTY

Interstate 75 Daytime northbound lane closures Sunday through Thursday from south of U.S. 90 (Exit 427) to north of Interstate 10 (Exit 435) for resurfacing.

Interstate 75 Daytime northbound lane closures of the emergency lane between the Alachua and Suwannee county lines to install fiber optic and pull boxes along the roadway shoulders.

State Road 100 Daytime lane closures weekdays after 8:30 a.m. between U.S. 90 and Academic Avenue to finish resurfacing.

U.S. 90 West Traffic has shifted to the south side of the road (new eastbound lanes) between Lake City Avenue and Brown Road. Northbound Turner Avenue is closed at U.S. 90. Traffic is detoured to Northwest Enterprise Way, to Northwest American Lane and back to Turner Road.

State Road 10A (Baya Drive) Nighttime lane closures Monday through Friday from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. from U.S. 90 East to U.S. 90 West in Lake City for drainage work.

HAMILTON COUNTY

Interstate 75 The northbound weigh-in-motion station south of U.S. 129 near White Springs is closed for concrete repairs to the ramps.

Interstate 75 Daytime lane closures of the emergency lane between the Suwannee County line and the Georgia line to install fiber optic along the roadway shoulders.

U.S. 41 The road will be temporarily closed Friday, February 12, from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. east of County Road 137 to move equipment from PCS Phosphate across the road. A detour will be posted.

U.S. 129 The road will be temporarily closed Tuesday from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. one mile north of Interstate 75 to move equipment from PCS Phosphate across the road. Traffic is detoured to County Road 158, to County Road 249, to County Road 132 and U.S. 41.

LAFAYETTE COUNTY

State Road 51 Daytime lane closures Monday through Thursday from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. between Mayo and the Taylor County line to repair shoulders.

LEVY COUNTY

County Road 326 Traffic is shifted to the new Waccassasa River bridge while the old bridge is removed. Traffic is reduced to one lane controlled by traffic signals.

SUWANNEE COUNTY

State Road 51 Daytime lane closures after 8:30 a.m. between the Lafayette County line and the roundabout in Live Oak for guardrail installation.

TAYLOR COUNTY

Johnson Stripling Road (County Road 361) Daytime lane closures after 8 a.m. between Pace Drive and Roberts Aman Road for widening the shoulders, installing guardrails and placing sod.

U.S. 19 Daytime northbound lane closures Monday through Thursday from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. between Salem and Tennille to repair shoulders.

U.S. 221 Possible daytime lane closures for maintenance on the temporary bridge which traffic is shifted to at the Econfina River in Shady Grove. The recommended speed limit is 35 mph.

UNION COUNTY

State Road 100 Daytime lane closures Monday through Friday after 8:30 a.m. and Saturday after 6 a.m. between the Columbia County line and Lake Butler for resurfacing.

State Road 121 Daytime lane closures weekdays after 8:30 a.m. between the Alachua County line and Lake Butler for resurfacing and sidewalk work.
