TRAFFIC ADVISORY

I-75 North outside lane and off-ramp at U.S. 441 (Exit 399) closing Sunday *Closed southbound on-ramp and outside lane scheduled to reopen Monday night*

Gainesville – The I-75 North outside lane and off-ramp to U.S. 441 at Exit 399 are scheduled to completely close to traffic Sunday at 8 p.m., weather permitting. The northbound outside lane and ramp will be closed for at least two weeks during pavement reconstruction.

The southbound on-ramp from U.S. 441 North and outside lane are scheduled to reopen Monday night after being closed since March 14 for pavement reconstruction. Reopening was delayed due to weather and unforeseen circumstances discovered during excavation.

Traffic on I-75 North will be reduced to two-lanes from the old CSX railroad bridge to U.S. 441 during the closures. The speed limit is reduced to 60 mph.

Traffic will detour five miles north to the County Road 236 (Exit 404) interchange to access I-75 South to U.S. 441.

The ramp/lane can be reopened early if work is completed ahead of schedule.

The \$23 million project to resurface 12 miles of I-75 from Northwest 39th Avenue to U.S. 441 and improve the Northwest 39th Avenue and U.S. 441 interchanges in Alachua County is scheduled for completion this fall.

We appreciate your patience during this construction to maintain Northeast Florida's interstate infrastructure. Of the 50 million people who travel by car into Florida, 40 million travel through District Two.
