I-10, I-295 ramp detours scheduled Monday through Wednesday nights

Jacksonville – The I-295 northbound ramp to I-10 eastbound will be closed from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. Monday and Tuesday and from 9 p.m. to midnight Wednesday. Detour is I-295 northbound to Commonwealth and Lane avenues.

Also, I-10 eastbound will be closed from the I-295 on-ramp to east of Lane Avenue from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. Monday and Tuesday and from 11 p.m. to midnight Wednesday. Detour is I-295 south to Normandy Boulevard to Lane Avenue.

I-10 westbound from east of Lane Avenue to west of Lane Avenue is scheduled to close from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. Monday and Tuesday and from 11 p.m. to midnight Wednesday. Detour is Lane Avenue north to Commonwealth Avenue and I-295 southbound.

Additionally, I-10 eastbound from east of Lane Avenue to west of Lane Avenue is scheduled to close from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. Monday and Tuesday and from 11 p.m. to midnight Wednesday. Detour is Lane Avenue north, Commonwealth Avenue and I-295 southbound.

The detours, weather permitting, are necessary during paving and pavement striping for the I-10 widening and operational improvements project.

State Road 100 east of Starke closing at railroad crossing Monday

3.5-mile detour in place during 5-day closure for crossing replacement

Starke – State Road 100 (East Madison Street) will completely close and all traffic detoured in the immediate area of the railroad crossing north of County Road 100A in Bradford County for five days beginning Monday at 9 a.m. The road is scheduled to reopen by 5 p.m. Friday, May 6, weather permitting.

During the closure, a 3.5-mile detour will be in place. Traffic will use State Road 100, U.S. 301 and Southeast 144th Street during the closure.

Law enforcement officers will assist with the closure and detour. The roadway will reopen early if work is completed ahead of schedule or could possibly be closed longer if there are weather delays.

The existing one-track railroad crossing, operated by Camp Blanding, is being replaced with a new concrete crossing designed to last longer under heavy traffic. The crossing area will also be resurfaced. Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is overseeing the project.

Rail is an important component of a healthy economy. It is a cost effective way to move people and goods efficiently, ultimately saving companies and people money. Rail is also a part of Florida's Strategic Intermodal System (SIS).
